FURTHER REGULATIONS**

To be read in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations for the event.

1 AUTHORITY:

The event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules of the Motorsport Australia, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Short Circuit Standing Regulations, the Short Circuit Vehicle Regulations, Short Circuit General Regulations, these Further Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions which may be issued in respect to Motorsport Australia Permit Number **421/2006/02**.

The Speed Event Standing Regulations refers only to the super sprints. The Short Circuit Standing Regulations, Vehicle Regulations and General Regulations refer only to the short circuit.

7 JUDGES OF FACT:

(e) The Clerk of the Course shall be deemed to Judges of Fact in respect to drifting.

8 START:

The event will commence at **10.00 a.m.** and will conclude at approximately 5.00 p.m. on Saturday 19th June 2021 and will continue from **10.00 a.m.** until approx. 3.00 p.m. on Sunday 20th June 2021.

9 ENTRIES

Competitors are required to report to the Administration area at the Control Tower to finalise any documentation issues and collect their information packs and hired transponders.

No Motorsport Australia licences will be issued on the day unless special arrangements have been made with the Secretary of the Meeting.

12 SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering will be held at Carnell Raceway, Stanthorpe from **2 p.m. to 5 p.m.** on Friday 19th June 2021 and from **8.00 a.m. to 9.15 a.m.** on Saturday 20 Jun 2021, however, vehicles may be scrutineered outside of these times at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and Chief Scrutineer.

If required special arrangements can be made with the Chief scrutineer for Sunday scrutiny.

Competitors will be required to have their timing transponders with them at scrutineering to check their number and to ensure they are mounted correctly and are in working order.

13 DRIVERS BRIEFING:

The compulsory attendance of all drivers is required at the driver's briefing to be held at the Canteen area on **Saturday 19th June 2021 at 9.30 a.m.** and **Sunday 20th June 2021 at 9.30 a.m.**

While drivers will not be required to sign on at the briefings the names of those who should be attending will be called out by a member of the administration staff and checked against an attendance sheet. A penalty will be imposed on competitors failing to attend the driver's briefing,

Note: Covid 19 Social distancing protocols are to be observed at the briefings.

14 INSURANCE::

2 Third Party Insurance: All competing vehicles carrying civil registration in Queensland require a Third Party extension certificate or letter (CTP) stating the full title of the event, location and date.

The extension document is to be brought to the event. **A Queensland registered vehicle will not be allowed to run without the extension.**

19 TIMING:

For those who wish to hire a timing transponder the hire rate is \$20.00 per unit, plus a refundable security deposit of **\$140.00 cash (\$160 in Total)** which is to be lodged on issue of the transponder. **Transponders will be available for sale for \$165.00.**

PLACEMENT OF TRANSPONDERS

Competitors must supply their own cable (zip) ties suitable to attach the transponder to the vehicle. Transponders must be placed on the vehicle so it has a direct line of sight to the ground. Each driver must have a separate transponder and only **one** transponder is to be on or in the competing vehicle at any time.

29 PENALTIES:

Drifting is not allowed. Any competitor drifting during competition may be excluded from the event. Any driver, considered by the Clerk of the Course in consultation with the stewards, driving in an unsportsmanlike manner will be excluded from the event.

33 APPAREL:

Competitors are reminded that the use of a Frontal Head Restraint is now a mandatory requirement for competitors of certain vehicle types and categories in Speed Events. These are outlined in the Motorsport Australia Manual and the attached Flowchart.

COMPETITORS NOTES:

(1) Catering

Catering will be available during the weekend. The Canteen will be open for Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning.

(2) COVID 19

This event is being run under the Motorsport Australia Return to Race and Queensland Health Covid management protocols. It is the responsibility of every person to do the right thing and be Covid safe.

The current Queensland Health Covid 19 requirements for holding an open air event have been eased considerably. There is no longer a requirement for event organisers to register and collect the details of those entering the event.

However we all need to keep making COVIDSafe choices including physical distancing and maintaining good hygiene practices.



Frontal Head Restraints in Speed Events Flow Chart

The use of Frontal Head Restraints (FHR) has become mandatory in SPEED Events for vehicles that are determined as meeting certain criteria. The following chart will aid in determining which vehicles will require the use of FHR:
