1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience, remember preferences, support security, and provide information about how visitors use a website.

Cookies may be **session cookies**, which are deleted when you close your browser, or **persistent cookies**, which remain on your device for a set period or until deleted.

2. How we use cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- ensure the website functions properly
- remember your preferences and cookie choices
- analyse website traffic and visitor behaviour
- improve website performance and user experience
- support website security and fraud prevention

3. Types of cookies we may use

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the website. They enable core functions such as page navigation, security, network management, accessibility, and remembering your cookie preferences.

Analytics and performance cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use the website, such as which pages are visited, how users move through the site, and whether the website is performing as expected. This helps us improve the site.

Functional cookies

These cookies may be used to remember choices you make, such as saved preferences, in order to provide a more consistent browsing experience.

Security cookies

Security-related cookies may be used to help protect the website and its forms from spam, abuse, and malicious activity.

4. Google reCAPTCHA

Our website contact page states that it is protected by **Google reCAPTCHA**. reCAPTCHA helps distinguish genuine users from automated or abusive activity.

When reCAPTCHA is active, Google may collect information such as IP address, browser and device information, user interaction data, time spent on the site, mouse movements, and other behavioural signals. Google may also use cookies and similar technologies as part of this service.

5. Legal basis for using cookies

Where cookies are strictly necessary for the operation, security, or basic functionality of the website, we rely on our legitimate interest in operating a secure and effective website.

Where cookies are non-essential, including analytics, performance, or functional cookies that are not strictly required, we rely on your consent. These cookies should only be placed where you have accepted them through our cookie banner or preference tool.

6. Cookie consent

When you first visit our website, you may be presented with a cookie banner asking you to accept or manage cookies.

You can change your cookie preferences at any time through the cookie settings tool where available, or through your browser settings. Disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality or performance of the website.

7. Third-party cookies and services

We may use third-party services on the website where needed for functionality, security, analytics, or communications.

These third parties may set cookies or process technical information when their services are active on the site. Where this happens, the relevant third party is responsible for its own cookies and related processing under its own privacy documentation.

8. Managing cookies

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through browser settings. You can usually view what cookies are stored on your device, delete cookies, block all cookies, block cookies from specific websites, or clear cookies when you close your browser.

9. International transfers
