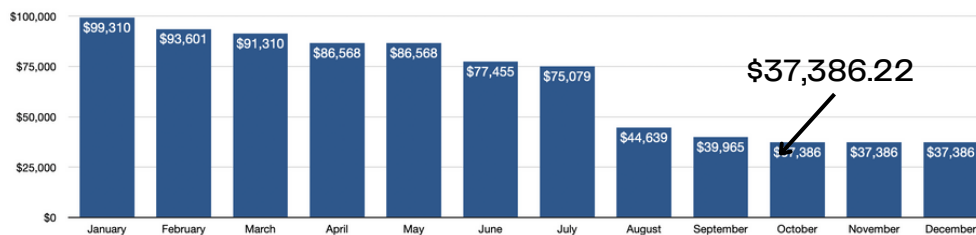

Trusting God's Promises

Scripture: Hebrews 10:23

Devotional Thought:
