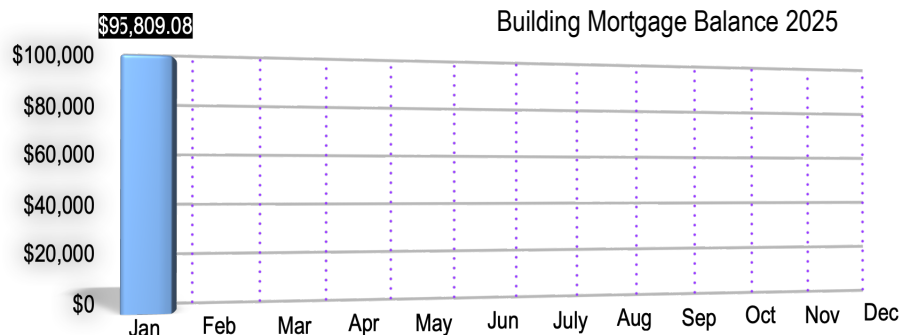
Harvest View Church,
