# Case Study: From Chaos to Confidence – How a Beauty Influencer Transformed Her Finances with Taxsmithing™

#### Overview

Isabella Reyes built her brand from scratch. What began in 2018 as a passion project on YouTube grew into a full-fledged beauty empire. Her finances were a mess.

Phase One: The Diagnosis – Going Back to Go Forward

#### What we uncovered:

- Misclassification of income: All influencer income—including gifted products and sponsorships—was reported as personal income with no cost basis.
- No business structure: She had no LLC or S-Corp—despite making over \$300,000 annually.
- No expense tracking: Nearly \$90,000 in legitimate business expenses over two years went unclaimed.
- Overlooked opportunities: Home office, travel deductions, content-related wardrobe, professional services, and even a portion of her rent should have been reducing her taxable income.

#### What we did:

- Reopened and amended 2022 and 2023 returns.
- Documented business intent and reclassified appropriate expenses.

- Created a written audit defense file for high-dollar items like luxury brand gifting campaigns.
- Educated Isabella on digital asset tracking and cash flow separation.

Results: We recovered \$38,762 in overpaid taxes, eliminated IRS penalties, and set her up with an S-Corp and business bank accounts by Q2 of the following year.

- S-Corp Optimization: Reasonable salary (\$60K), rest routed as distributions, saving ~\$9,800/year in SE tax.
- Family Management Company: Paid her sister for content support. \$12,000 shifted to lower bracket.
- Content Creation Write-Off Matrix: Guide for what's deductible—gear, glam, wardrobe.
- Accountable Plan: Documented and reimbursed travel, saving another \$11,000/year.
- Monthly CFO Calls: Quarterly check-ins to project income and track tax savings.

#### **Phase Three: Confidence and Control**

Today, Isabella runs her influencer brand like a real company—because it is.

Her content calendar is synced with her marketing and financial goals. She knows exactly what she's bringing in, what she can reinvest, and how much she should set aside for taxes. For the first time, she feels in control.
