*Estimated Usage refers to complete skeins of thread. This quantity is based on 1 thread over 2 on 28 count linen and includes usage for the entire series. I rounded up the quantity by at least half of a skein in all cases, to account for different stitching styles. If you plan to use 2 threads over 2, you will need more.

If you are kitting for an individual chart, you will likely need much less than one skein of each called for color.
