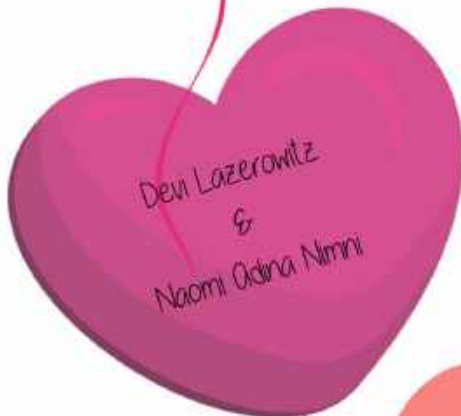

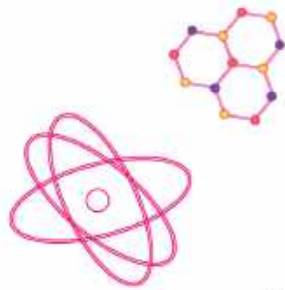

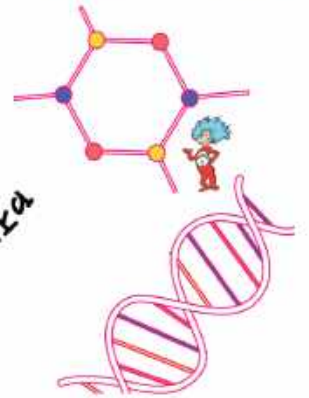

Dvar Torah

Parshas: Pinchas

Parshas Pinchas contains a long list of sacrifices that are brought on various occasions. The first one that the Torah discusses is the Korban Tamid – a Korban that was brought every single day, twice a day. When the Bais HaMikdash is standing, there is a mitzvah to offer a Tamid Offering, every single day: "One Lamb is to be offered in the morning and one Lamb is to be brought toward the evening" [Bamidbar 28:4]. This offering is brought every day of the year, even on Shabbos, even on Yom Kippur. Then later on in the Parsha, the Torah inserts a pasuk into the middle of the description of the Korban Tamid: "The continual Burnt Offering, which was made at Mt. Sinai for a pleasant aroma, a Fire Offering, before HaShem [Bamidbar 28:6]" What does the Olah that was brought on Mt. Sinai have to do with this section about the Daily Korban? That which happened on Mt. Sinai is history! Why is it mentioned in the middle of the section of the Korban Tamid?

When something is done day in day out, as wonderful as it may be, it eventually becomes done by rote. It becomes stale. It becomes automatic, without thought.

Many people become very excited to do a mitzvah for the first time. For example, when a girl becomes bas mitzvah she feels so excited to do all the mitzvos she's obligated in. Even fasting on Yom Kippur! But as the years go on and she gets more and more used to it, the excitement tends to fade. Or a girl who just learned how to daven Shmoneh Esrei. She's so excited to stand with her feet together and daven like all the older girls do. Then as time goes on, that excitement and enthusiasm fades. She no longer is excited in the mitzvah.

Our Torah inserts the pasuk about the Korban given at Har Sinai as if to say: "Remember that first Tamid?! Remember that the Tamid that was brought on Har Sinai with tremendous enthusiasm, newness and excitement?! Remember that! There should always be a little of that Tamid in the Tamid that is brought every single day. This is the goal and this is the lesson of the Korban Tamid. It needs to be "One every morning and one every evening" but it also must be "like the first one which was ever offered, on Mt. Sinai"

With Hashem's help, may we all feel privileged and excited to do the mitzvos every single day!

- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 tsp baking powder
