"The Truth of the Matter" Part I

The color of this message is green; the subject is life eternal, without death. The question of the day is: Is it possible to get to the kingdom of God without seeing death? The answer is: Yes, it has been done before, and will be done again. The Wisdom of God set the plans of salvation in motion, by empowering the three great but different time periods. First, there was the Old Covenant which started, during the time of Moses; the Gospel Dispensation was next, beginning at the death of Christ on the cross, and last is the New Covenant, which started at the end of the world, or the six day war, in 1967.

The covenant of Moses consisted of many laws, ordinances, and animal blood sacrifices; which was a collective system of checks and balances; agreed upon by both God and man. This produced the hope of salvation after death, all was aware that they would be resurrected at the appointed time. This covenant stood in force until it was taken out by the power of Christ on the cross. Therefore, anyone abiding by laws of the old covenant would be in violation of the true worship of God. At this point, the Gospel Dispensation began its preaching from Jerusalem, stretching throughout the world. It was the good news of Christ, his life, his instructions, his guaranteeing of salvation and eternal life, by the power of his resurrection. This is also known as the time of the Gentiles, which was to last until the recalling of Israel.

All of the righteous of Israel throughout the generations; lived and died awaiting the fulfillment of the prophecy concerning the return of the Jews to Jerusalem; and the rebuilding of the Tabernacle of David. God visited a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church, who lived according to the Commandments of God, and the Testimonies of Jesus Christ. When the leadership of that church began to waiver; and sought to add to and change the doctrine, that selfsame servant, along with his family withdrew; and turned his home into a place of worship. While raising his family according to the pure word of God; he was blessed with the spirit of prophecy. It was from this experience, that he accepted the assignment to preach the everlasting Gospel, and judgment of God. Brother Webb wrote many letters and booklets which were sent to leaders of nations, throughout the world. He told them to fear God, "Fear God and Give Glory to him for the hour of his judgment has come." This work was completed in the 1950's. As expected, his words were not adhered to by the nation's leaders. Then unexpectedly, in 1967, a six day war broke out in Palestine; involving various nations over the rights to Jerusalem. As we recall, the true Jews, are serving under the curses of Deuteronomy; in the land of the United States of America, at this point in time. The Jewish people, who had become an organized state in 1949, won the war, thus, the flag of Israel was restored over Jerusalem, for the first time, since the invasion of Rome in A.D. 56. This let the prophet know that the Gospel had ended and it was time for the rebuilding of the Tabernacle of David.

"The Truth of the Matter" Part III

The Wisdom of God, also referred to as Zion, wishes to make all things clear concerning the plans of salvation; in respect to the power and gifts of the covenants. Both have entrance into the kingdom of God, one is called the resurrection, and the other is called a deliverance, which we will study at this time. Here is the magnification of the spiritual seed of Christ, while still alive in the flesh. This deliverance is done by the Wisdom of God, under a rebirth. St. John 3:5 - "Jesus answered, "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." Simply speaking, the Wisdom of God takes the Holy Spirit of Christ under the symbol of water; she then plants the seed in perfect concordance, with the plans of salvation. The seed begins to grow, but the difference at this time, is that it is planted during the new covenant or (after those days), which refers to the ten year persecution of the Wave Sheaf group, at the hands of the dragon. Thus, if at the end of those days, all conditions are met, (a) nourishment complete, having been properly nourished by the testimonies of Jesus, (b) timing being correct, the book of times goes into activation; at the standing up of Michael, (c) activation of the spiritual harvest hour, which is the time of the harvest, a deliverance while standing on your feet, or while still living will occur, this is called a travailing birth.

"New Covenant Church - Deliverance"

- 1. Seeing that all things are set to time; when should we look for the deliverer, Michael to stand up? Daniel 12:1

 *Note They that are written in the book, will have met the conditions, again we say that all Israel shall be saved.
- 3. During this time period of deliverance, we see a change while standing on our feet, what is said of all Israel that have died before us? Daniel 12:2
- 4. How will the Wave Sheaf appear after ten years of great tribulation? Revelation 7:13-14
- 5. Since the redemption of the church is seen under the symbol of a wheat harvest; what instruction is given to us today? Zechariah 10:1
- 6. What is the amazing factor about the birth of Zion's children? Isaiah 66:7-8

*Note – Dear friend, Isaiah 66:7 and Revelation 12:5 speaks to Brother Webb having a rebirth of knowledge. However, Isaiah 66:8 speaks to the statement that Christ made that every man must be reborn. You can be reborn while having a change while standing on your feet, or through the resurrection, both processes, are a rebirth into heaven.

"The Truth of the Matter" Part IV

Dear Friend, we are commanded of our God, to make the differences between the resurrection and the deliverance which is a (change while standing on your feet), so that they can never be misapplied or confused. It is the will of God that the saints obtain the pure word of God, on the operations of divine personnel involved in each process. As previously noted, the Wisdom of God takes charge personally concerning the deliverance of saints while still alive, and the blood of Jesus activates the resurrection. According to the plans of salvation, there will be three resurrections. First, a special resurrection will be given to all Israel who died over the centuries, regardless of righteousness, or unrighteousness. Daniel 12:2 states, "And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt." Second, is the general resurrection of the saints, all the righteous who died over the many centuries, and the gentiles killed under the beast, are released from the grip of death, by the blood and voice of Christ. Third, is the resurrection of the wicked and unsaved, this happens after the executive judgment of the fourteen plagues under which they were killed. For they too, were forced out of the ground by the blood of Christ, it is at this time that they will be thrown into the Lake of Fire, this is called the second death.

"The Resurrection"

*Note- Whenever one is delivered; there is no body to bury. I repeat the deliverance leaves no body for burial; therefore no funeral can be carried out. As with Enoch and Elijah, they had no funeral services. II Kings 2:6-17and Hebrews 11:5-6

We will notice the term "Caught Up" mentioned concerning the "Man-child", known to us as Brother James T. Webb. In Revelation 12:5, the words caught up; do not refer to a deliverance from death, but a rebirth of knowledge, concerning the mysteries of God. We, as well as some of you, did attend his funeral and sang over his dead body. We went to the gravesite, and stood with his family as the body was lowered into the grave. Brother James T. Webb "died"- and is awaiting the resurrection of Israel. However, as with Paul the Apostle, being the administrator of the Gospel, James T. Webb, was the administrator of the new covenant. Both men were privy to the divine mysteries of God, according to Wisdom's plan of salvation. Both were caught up by God, in terms of a rebirth of knowledge. Paul stated "Whether in the body, I cannot tell: or whether out of the body I cannot tell: God knoweth such a one caught up to the third heaven." Now verse four says, that he was caught up into paradise and heard unspeakable words, which were unlawful for man to utter. There is no record of Paul being delivered, however, he did use the term "caught up" to describe his experience with God, in respect a rebirth of divine knowledge. Finally, please note Paul's statement on this matter; "It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord." Now with Brother Webb, surnamed of God Zerubbabel, he being an administrator of the everlasting gospel, also experienced being "caught up". This experience is of divine revelation, for it was said, "Who art thou, oh Great Mountain? Before Zerubbabel, thou shalt become a plain." We see both men had the same experience with being caught up.

*Note-Brother Webb was taken down the middle of the road and given perfect understanding of both the kingdom of darkness and the throne of God. Here we see the truth of the matter is his being caught up unto God: the divine knowledge that he received just like the Apostle Paul.
