"The Message of Elijah Zerubbabel's Prophecy Fulfilled" Part II

The prophecy of Zerubbabel, concerning the ancient men, started with the Church of the Laodiceans. Today these churches are known as the Seventh Day Adventist, and the Church of God and Saints of Christ. These are the last two Sabbath Keeping churches of our time. From these two churches shall come the 144,000 of Israel. Brother Webb was once a member of both of these churches; until the leadership of both groups displayed abominations; by removing the testimonies of Jesus. Once this occurred, he removed himself and his family. The ninth chapter of Ezekiel is dedicated to the judgment that shall fall upon those who mislead God's people and attempt to change the holy doctrine. Brother Webb's booklet entitled "The Deadly Wound is Healed" page 4, bottom half of paragraph 2 quotes - "The Lord will suddenly visit Laodicea in a great message of Elijah, which is the power in his hands to clean house. Guile and false doctrine will be the issue, and many people will get the surprise of their lives". The great surprise will be; when the true identities of the tares are revealed, (the ancient men). Further quoting from the "Deadly Wound is Healed" "As the message of Elijah becomes a reproof and correction, a message of rebuke, repentance and decision, much sorrow and tears are in store as the message is brought to bare against the house of God for the third, and last time". Page 5 paragraph 1, "Falling sharp on the heels of the message, it also will become a media of separation in the Church as a decision is being made. Many will be spewed out of his mouth. Now understand that the spewing out is a matter of decision(s) taken on the issues. This is the process by which the wheat shall be separated from the tares."

In 1969, the Lord informed Brother Webb; that the judgment and atonement work had taken place, thereby, cleansing the heavenly records of all sin. However, two years earlier in 1967, a six day war broke out in the Middle East, where the Jews that took on the identities of Israel, captured the land. From these two events, Brother Webb was able to recognize the prophetical understanding as it related to Israel. The events let him know that the Gospel Dispensation had ended, and the time of the New Covenant was to begin, bringing with it the recall of Israel. With these issues clear in his mind, the spirit of God gave him another assignment, which was the rebuilding of the Tabernacle of David. During this process, he and his family accepted all that came through the doors of the church without question. They were taught the commandments and testimonies, set up under the direction and spirit of God. Several departments were used for the functioning and survival of the church. The Wisdom of God would have us clearly understand that the Tabernacle of David took the place of Laodicea. Now, Laodicea became unacceptable to God; due to their acceptance of the testimonies of a fake Prophetess. God gave the spirit of Elijah to Brother Webb, to condemn this abomination. After this work, the Lord raised up the Tabernacle of David. The devil foolishly believed that he had a victory over God; because the last two Sabbath Keeping Churches had turned to unrighteousness. The Wisdom of God set a plan in place that would have the Wave Sheaf group rise up, and through them; she would gather the 144,000, including the righteous that are left within these Sabbath Keeping Churches.

As we previously mentioned, the dragon kingdom foolishly thought they had scored a resounding victory over the plans of salvation; when they caused Laodicea to fall. After realizing their defeat and the rebuilding of Israel was taking place, they quickly proclaimed war on "The Little Church" from its very conception. They manipulated their seed to the forefront of the church; by deeds of false meekness and willingness to serve. Once they gained the confidence of the church, the dragon awaited the right moment in which to strike. That moment came, (so they thought) with the death of Zerubbabel. With him gone, the dragon placed within the heart of his seed, the desire for complete autonomy, over God's people. This is the same way that he did Laodicea. His attempt was to make Wisdom's first fruit of the harvest, unacceptable, but let not the saints fear; this is an impossible feat. Wisdom has transferred the spirit of Elijah from Zerubbabel to certain servants; these servants are called "The Hands of Zerubbabel." The rebirth of knowledge given to Brother Webb was now within these men and women referred to by the Prophet Zechariah as "Zerubbabel's Hands." The knowledge within them is also called oil that they will pour out of themselves for the purpose of cleaning out the church from the spirit of ungodliness and sorcery. The surprise in this case; is that the war of Revelation 12:17 is from within the church walls, administered by the ancient men. Therefore, God shall send his deliverer and ungodliness will be removed.
