“Mother Wisdom’s Message to the Wise”

Part I

Come and sit at his table, for you belong to the Wisdom of God. She has a place setting for you. You, who have been ridiculed, talked about, cast aside, and forgotten, are the Lord’s choice. To be more specific, we are speaking of the “Children of God” whom the devil attack through the false prophets and demonic influence of the leadership of the Tabernacle of David. These in leadership positions are also referred to as “Ancient Men” by the Prophet Ezekiel. Christ referred to them as “the bad” that attended the marriage... without being invited.

Think not that God has forgotten your pain or humiliation! Think not that God has sanctioned the decision that separated you from your parents, siblings, church, and all that you knew and loved! This was ordered by the Knowledge of Evil, and carried out by the seed of the serpent. God allowed these things in order to fulfill the scriptures and to show forth his mighty wonders and spirit power. We recall how in Egypt they were delivered by power and might. This time the deliverance will be done by the Wisdom of God. *Zechariah 4:6, “Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.”*

“God Never Left You”

1. It has been the teaching of the Ancient Men that no one who is a member in good standing should have any association with former members; this includes casual greetings. How does this doctrine compare with the teachings of Jesus? Matthew 5:44-48
2. What is the danger for someone who teaches against the laws and testimonies? Matthew 5:19-20
***Note:** Scribes and Pharisees were antichrists, today they are seen as “Ancient Men” or “Church Leaders”.
3. Seeing that the church is under the influence of ungodliness, what record do we have that shows Satan has used men in this manner in previous times? Acts 8:9-11
4. As we view the state of the Household of Israel in the ungodliness that plagues it, what comfort is given to us at this time? Romans 11:26
5. What is the outcome of all the saints that have suffered, due to the teachings of the “Ancient Men” (seen by God as abominations)? Ezekiel 9:4
6. Even though the “Ancient Men” seem to have unquestionable status among the people, what will be their fates once the deliverer removes the ungodliness? Ezekiel 9: 5-6
