

THE LITTLE BOOK OF THE SEVEN SEALS! CLASS PART 1

Scripture: Luke 10:21

Chapter: Rev. 5th

Memory Verse: Rev. 1:1

The content of the book of the seven seals is the mysteries of God, covering episodes in the Drama of Life, from the Prophet Daniel to the Battle of Armageddon. The great mysteries of the sealed book start with the Prophet Daniel who wanted to know the end of the wonders. As we take note of his vision, he heard a conversation between two angels who spoke of the summation of the mysteries, **Dan. 8:13. "Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain saint which spake, How long shall be the vision concerning the daily sacrifice, and transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot"? Verse 14: "and he said unto me, unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed"**. Now Daniel heard these things but was not given the full understanding.

Who Shall Understand?

1. **Why** wasn't the understanding of the mysteries of **The Little Books** given to Daniel? **Dan. 12:7-9**
2. Seeing that Daniel had to close the book, **What** would happen at the time of the end? **Dan. 12:4,10.**
3. Under **what** Spirit do we receive **Divine** prophecy? **Rev. 19:10**

The Opening of the Little Book!

4. **What** was the cry that went out by the angel concerning **the Little Book**? **Rev. 5:2**
5. After the announcement of the angel; **Why** did the prophet weep? **Rev. 5:3,4**
6. **What** wonderful and glorious thing did an elder say unto the prophet? **Rev. 5:5**
7. Seeing that Christ was the only one worthy to open the **Little Book**, **What** is his requirements to all that receive the **Little Book**? **Rev. 10:9-11**

Note: Key words we need to have understanding of:

Daily sacrifice: Levitical priesthood offering of animals.

Trodding down sanctuary and Host: Christ dying on the cross and city and people completely destroyed in AD. 70 by Titus.

This is the beginning of the Gospel period, the start of the 2300 days!
