Revelation 6:6 – “And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.” The oil and wine represent the doctrine of the holy laws and testimonies of Jesus, and the joy of serving God. These words are as a watch word or a warning to us. Serving God is our duty, which should be done; with obedience and joy. The devil had a different plan; he would manipulate his seed into the leadership of the wave sheaf group. By the spirit of fear and intimidation, he would try to force them to observe practices or characteristics; that are contrary to the testimonies, in an effort to make the entire harvest unacceptable. Through lying visions and demonic orations, he would try to confuse the saints, as to the will of God. “The Long Awaited Hour of Deliverance Has Come” Part III

There is an amazing contrast between the deliverance of old during the period of Moses; in comparison to this moment in time and our current experiences. First, old Pharaoh became paranoid about the curses all around him, and the constant persuasion to let the children of Israel go. After the people left Egypt and went into the wilderness, they saw Pharaoh and his army; approaching them in hot pursuit. Therefore, they cried out to the Lord for help. This too is the experience of the Wave Sheaf with the evil host of spirit forces attempting to stop their deliverance, they too cry out to God for help. In the time of old, the Lord used water to stop Pharaoh and his host. Again, water is used to turn the tide against the seed of the Dragon. The Wisdom of God deflected the attack of the flood, which was directed at the saints, and she sent it towards the tares. As the Egyptians were drowned in the sea, so were the tares drowned in the spiritual waters of the Dragon. Yet, in this case, these waters matured them in evil, whereas they became merciless in their judgment towards the saints, and every decision they make reflects war against the laws and testimonies of Jesus.

Soon the dragon will realize his loss and become enraged against his own seed, which have failed him in his effort to stop the deliverance. He shall reveal unto them, that they are his, and begin his torment of them, as with Judas during the time of Christ. At the same time, God will make it known to them that they are not, and never were his. They will beg God and claim that they have prophesied in his name, did many wonderful things, yet he will say unto them, “I never knew you.” It is here that they will blame James T. Webb, for their loss, for accepting them into the Leadership of the church. Blessed is he that is not offended by these sayings.
