TRIMMING OUR LAMPS!!!**

Scripture: Zechariah 4:2

Chapter Reading Matt. 5:13-24

Memory Verse: 25:4

We all love each other with all our heart, with this being said, the Lord presents to us at this time a message of encouragement. The Lord, whom has chosen us, chose us not by our righteous deeds but by our faith, which is our way of expressing the love of our God. As we bare witness with our own eyes to the fulfillment of the prophecy of James T. Webb and as we sit back and watch the voice of God in activation of all three distress signals of judgment promised to the world by God, we would do well that we all seek to trim our lamps. Peter makes it very clear that the love and forgiveness towards all is the key. Here is what keeps the wicked from being delivered. Here is what condemns the forces of darkness. They cannot show love neither can they show forgiveness!!! This is why the attack of ungodliness—that attacked the Tabernacle of David Church—was focused on destroying love, for it is the key to being born of God!!!

1. As Mother Wisdom is preparing her children to enter the barn, What is the difference between the wise and the foolish in this parable? **Matt. 25:3,4**
2. We see here that both groups had to be awakened in their minds in order to meet the bridegroom, What did they all do once they woke up? **Matt. 25:5-7**
3. After both parties arose and was aware of the time what horrifying and shocking event took place in the minds of the foolish causing devastating pain? **Matt. 25:8-13**
4. Now that we fully understand that we must not delay when following the instructions from the spirit, explain the parable in this text. **St. John 6:50,51**
5. What statement is made here that lets us know, that the showing of love is at the top of the list of all saints? **1 Peter 4:8**
