This was done by the four divisions of angels who control the elements, namely water, heat, cold, and wind. There is also an angel who is commanded to wreck the business world; he is under the spirit of the black horse. There are four divisions of angels mentioned in both the revelations and by Ezekiel. These angels make up the wheel or the throne of God, as seen in Ezekiel’s vision.
