"The Third Distress" Part I: Secrets, Climatic Events and the Resurrection

We joined the Tabernacle of David Church, as teenagers. We have had many spiritual experiences since then. The one constant in our lives has been our belief in the commandments of God and the testimonies of Jesus Christ. We are eternally thankful for our relationship with the Wisdom of God, and understanding of the prophetical works of James T. Webb. In our study of the message of the covenant (the works of James T. Webb), we were never wise enough to see that which Mother Wisdom had plainly placed before our eyes concerning the "Book of Deliverance" and the "Book of Resurrection". Another secret we shall we shall visit is the "Book of Resurrection" referencing Revelation 6:9-11: (v9) And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: (v10) And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? (v11) And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled." As we noticed, the saints who are already deceased had to wait for other saints who were slated to die as they had. They will all be resurrected together under the sixth seal. We need to understand that the death of both groups has already been recorded in the Book of Resurrection from the foundation of the world. The Book of Resurrection is a book within the Book of the Seven Seals, just as the Book of Daniel is a book within itself, inside of the books of the bible.

"The Third Distress" Part II: Resurrection of the Man-Child

The work of God came not to the Prophet himself, but to his mother. While James T. Webb was but five years old, she was given a night dream. She saw him playing in the yard and a bird followed him everywhere he went, singing these words over and over: "He is a proper child; he is a proper child." Brother Webb's parents knew that the Lord was with him. Though they did not fully understand, they protected him and allowed him to do the Lord's work as the spirit moved him. Vision of Brother Webb – "When I was 17, I had my first vision of this work. It was a dark night. Three men were standing with me. I was the front man. In this darkness I only had a match, which I lit and it made a large circular light around my knees. Then as I looked to the heavens a star did the same thing. A circular light and then a burning lamp fell to the earth and soon as it came to the ground, the whole earth was in a light brighter than the sun. I saw a circle of booklets on the ground, which the star left and on the back of them was written in red letters as a fire saying, "You Get Ready!" We went every way delivering the books by which the earth was a light greater than the sun. Christ closed my book and took it with him." After that a golden letter was given to me with raised letters that could be felt with the hand. I would read this when I finished my work." Brother Webb will be **resurrected** at the appointed moment of the resurrection of Israel. He shall be sent to the church with a golden letter, which he shall read to the members himself. This is his final act in respect to the Tabernacle of David and the finishing of his work. This is why he always promised the church that he would meet us there!
