## "Thy Deliverer Hast Come" Part I

As previously mentioned in other letters, the Tabernacle of David Church; was founded on the faith of Jesus and the sound doctrine of the Laws and Testimonies. Yet, the Apostles foresaw by the spirit of prophecy; and recorded in their writings; that the "Little Church" would experience ungodliness, which is wickedness and disrespect with no reverence to God. The question of the hour is: Where did this ungodliness come from? We do not want anyone confused concerning the deliverance from ungodliness, and the deliverance from evil, which Christ spoke of in his prayer on the mount. The deliverance from ungodliness is a deliverance from evil policies, and false teachings against the testimonies. The deliverance spoken of by Christ in the Sermon on the Mount; is a deliverance from the evil within our minds that was set within, in the Garden of Eden, from the sin of Adam. Now let's turn our attention to the first deliverance. During this particular point in time, ungodliness will be removed, which includes the removal of all false policies, and those that facilitate them. So the answer to our question is simple; the ancient men which were before the house. They set policies that led the church astray. They tampered with the holy doctrine and the covenant of the church; and must now face judgment.

## "The First Deliverance"

- 1. What is causing the pain that makes the saints cry out to God? Ezekiel 9:4

  \*Note When one cries out to God and asks why the leadership is picking on them, or are made to fear whenever the leadership is near, God has set a mark upon their forehead.
- 2. During the hour in which the Lord will separate the tares from the saints, what advice is given concerning that which causes division and offence contrary to the doctrine of truth? Romans 16:17
- 3. Seeing that the saints will receive a mark from the protecting angels by crying out against the abominations brought into the church by the ancient men, who will be deceived by the ancient men's fair speeches? Romans 16:18
- 4. What word of proof do we have showing that the removal of the tares is the first deliverance from evil? Matthew 13:30
- 5. What other words are spoken by the spirit letting all know that God will put an end to all ungodliness and teaching of evil policies? Titus 1:10-11

## "Thy Deliverer Hast Come" Part II

Christ used the human body, taken from the cross by way of resurrection to heaven, for two purposes. One, using the blood to cleanse the records of all saints, and two; to minimize and measure the spirit of God, sent down to man. This way, the creative forces, would not overload man. In the same way that a surge protector shields a computer from overloading, the resurrected body of Christ; became qualified as a "surge protector" to de-amplify the divine spirit of God. As we have covered in our previous studies, the spirit is transported through pipes, or a conduit type process. From the throne of God, down to man, if it is not measured; no human being would be able to handle its' awesome power. We saw this example, after Christ was resurrected, because it was told to Mary not to touch him; until after he had returned from visiting his father in heaven. This process is the deliverance from evil inside the flesh; and is also the second deliverance of the Tabernacle of David. Once this occurs, there will be no evil inside a person's mind.

### "The Second Deliverance"

- 1. What happened to the woman who suffered from an illness of over a twelve year span? And what did Jesus say to her? Mark 5:25-34
- 2. What other proof do we have; that lets us know that a measured amount of virtue came out of the body of Jesus that had power to overcome sickness and disease? Luke 6:17-19
- 3. After Jesus was resurrected, what did he say to Mary regarding touching him and why? St. John 20:17
- 4. Once resurrected, Jesus went to heaven to meet with his father; where they performed a process on his human flesh. Were the disciples able to touch him once the process was completed? St. John 20:26-27
- 5. In the prayer that Jesus left for us to say on a daily basis; what must be asked of God concerning evil? Matthew 6:13
- 6. What is the process and method, by which this deliverance shall be done? Revelation 5:6
- 7. When Christ shares with us; the seven spirits that come directly from his body, what affect will this have on our minds? Hebrews 10:16-17
- 8. Before this process takes place; what is the condition of our mind? Romans 7:22-23
