ZEAL AS RAIN!

The prophet makes it clear that both the former and the latter rains were sent in the first month. Wisdom revealed the former rains as a rain of repentance and gathering and the latter ran as a rain of zeal. As we check the vision of the prophet to see its correlation with the scripture, the prophet revealed that after he put the shirt around the baby, and walked a little further, he noticed the burners on the stove came on, giving heat!!! Here is the return of the zeal: the time of the latter rain, which enabled HOZ to create a complete website of communication containing the light of God's truth!! This zeal will grow in heat until the entire church of saints has been embraced by its warmth!! This second pouring of the "Latter rain" now works in conjunction with the third rain or "harvest rain", as it will enable the saints to return to God...no matter what condition of attack the dragon has placed them in over the years. The harvest rain is a rain of separation and harvest. Again, the harvest rain will separate the saints in the church from the tares. This fiery baptism of Christ will remove evil from their minds, and it is here that the saints shall be rewarded with the last rain of their experience called "the rain of righteousness."

DIVIDED RAIN!

Let us examine the Lord's statement of the "divided rain". "And he sendeth rain on the just and unjust." Now please compare this with, "And I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city; one piece was rained upon and the piece whereupon it rained not withered." Amos spoke concerning the condition of the "Tares" during the harvest time; for the rain given at harvest will cause separation by order of the Lord. Now as the "Tares are being gathered; the saint will be reasoning out their conditions with God. This reasoning will be done in the "barn of the Lord" for he did say "... gather my wheat into my barn." All anointed saints... regardless of their present condition... are welcome to come to the barn of the Lord and receive the washing and reasoning. The late hour or the time of your absence from righteousness means absolutely nothing to God!! If one is willing to enter the barn of the Lord it is possible to reason out whatever the condition may be. The prophet Webb was shown a vision in which he was in a wheel barrel. As he left the barrel, he noticed much dirt on his skin. He stated that he then went to the Wisdom of God's home and was directed to the bathroom to wash. There, he removed the dirt by the power of the Lord's fuller soap found in the bathroom.

1. During this crucial hour as we continue to work out our salvation, who is given the authority to confront the tares? Matt. 13:30 Note: the event of the gathering takes place in the mind of both saints and tares.
2. Now that we understand the rains are a symbol of our minds being cleansed from evil thoughts or ways, what action will this cause the saint's to make? Isa. 1: 18,19
3. We all know that the spirit of mourning is no laughing matter, what comforting statement is said to his saints in this hour? Rev. 3:19-22
4. Knowing full well, that God sends rain on both saints and tares, what is said in this text that proves that this rain is divided? Isa. 1:19,20
5. The tares shall also receive their portion of rain, but not the rain of righteousness seen by Daniel. They will be divided and separated from the saints to receive their portion of rain, does the bible agree with this? Yes or No? Psalms 11:6

Memory Verse: Rev. 3:22

THE PURGING SHALL COME!

John the Baptist states, "He shall thoroughly purge his floor." Isaiah put the action of this season this way, "Prepare ye the way of the people, cast up, cast up the highway, gather out the stones, lift up a standard for thy people." A special time period is set for us the Wavesheaf. Notice it says Christ will thoroughly purge his floor. Webster on the word floor: is the corresponding surface of anything. Webster on corresponding is agreement, conformity and/or communication by exchange of letters. As we examine these definitions it is clear that the purging will begin with HOZ, for we would be his floor of the message. God does this to make sure we are on one accord in our thoughts as well as our writings. Webster on the word 'and' means as a result of. Thus, the time of purging comes first; we will not enter the barn of the Lord until we have been thoroughly purged of anything offensive before God. Be clear that the word 'and' separates the time of the "purging" from the time of "entering" into the barn. All of us must pass through this process, and that it shall begin with HOZ. This personal reasoning shall be done by the spirit of God only. It is expedient that we do not resist this reasoning. It is for our salvation.

1. After first establishing a permanent standard for the remnant, what accomplishments are achieved in the process? Isaiah 62:10
2. As we thank the Lord for this wonderful understanding, and using stones as our example, what is said concerning the subject? Eccl. 3:5
3. Knowing full well, that we do not have the ability to purge ourselves, Give an itemized account of the events in this process. Rev. 3:18-22
4. During the procedure where Christ thoroughly purges his floor, What statement is made that lets us know that we must both hear and obey his word? Isaiah 1:18-20
5. Mother Wisdom's plan calls for her wheat to enter into the barn after the purging, What is said of all that do not heed her advice? Romans 13:1,2 (P.S. Many visions and dreams were given concerning this hour, we are required to humble ourselves and focus on the reasoning and standards).

CLEANSING RAIN!!!

This letter is inspired by God to give the Light of Truth. We whom have been through a terrible war of the mind with the kingdom of darkness, have now reached the Harvest Time. So now, we ask the **Lord Rain** in its time. The **Rain** comes to us as **Zeal** to bring about **PERFECTION** in the **Time of the Harvest!**

3. Giving thanks always for the wonderful blessings, we found hid in the sand, what must we do at this time and what is our reward for obeying? I John 1:9
4. Now on the saint's having knowledge of the time of deliverance, describe the events related to the subject of time? II Kings 2:1-3
5. Having received full knowledge and understanding as to when to ask for the Lord's rain, what will be the outcome who call on his name? Joel 2:32
