Why did God surname Brother Webb, Zerubbabel? Let's take a look at history to get the answer. Zerubbabel was the governor of Judah, to whom the king had given written orders, which allowed him to go and rebuild The Household of Israel, after they had returned from exile in Babylon. They received opposition from surrounding nations, and Zerubbabel was charged to deal with the judgment of those who opposed. As Haggai mentioned, he was given a signet which in ancient times, was either a scroll, the kings ring, or some other significant item that let everyone know that whatever he was doing; was sanctioned by the king. Though others may disagree with what he was doing, they dared not go against the orders of the king. Now, in relationship to Brother Webb, he too had been given orders by the King of Kings. His orders were to rebuild the Tabernacle of David; which had fallen down. As Zerubbabel did long ago, he set up this project, delegated the proper people in positions best suited for the tasks at hand, initiated it, and history shows no more significant interaction from Zerubbabel. Yet, he was credited with being the architect of this project. This selfsame spirit is transferred to Brother Webb. In his work, he would deal with both judgment and salvation, which is under the color code of red and green. He would also set up the Household of Israel, Tabernacle of David, but would not be the overseer of day to day operations, just like Zerubbabel of old.

"I Guarantee" Part IV

It was well understood in Israel, that God would use his spirit for particular operations from person to person. He transferred the spirit of Elijah, to Elisha. In the last days, we will witness the spirits of Elijah, Moses, and others. *Notice: Malachi 4:5 "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord:" The prophecy of Malachi came almost five hundred years after the time of Elijah. During the time of Christ, they were looking for someone who would have this spirit. Some even thought this applied to Christ, that maybe he was Elijah; the same was said of John the Baptist. The key point would be before the great and dreadful day of the Lord. This day did not occur under the old covenant or under the gospel, but this prophecy would correlate directly under the time of James T. Webb's work. Let's establish a point here with all prophets; they must accept the assignment from God first, because he does not force you to do his will. We all remember the story of Jonah, also Apostle Paul had a similar case, and they accepted God's assignment. The assignment that Brother Webb accepted was to rebuild the Household of Israel. Once he accepted, he was assured that his family would be under the shadow of the Almighty. Brother Webb utilized his family, (wife and children) to set up the "Little Church." They had already been groomed under the direction of the Wisdom of God. The church was set up, with a foundation of twelve elders, who were to make decisions concerning the day to day operations, and not one man. Even the prophet himself, was careful not to exceed his authority, but he stayed humble, and allowed people to do the jobs that they were appointed to do.
