Nations, Time Zones and Symbols

Gen.6:11-12

Most of the nations mentioned below have some of the symbols and a national emblem of their country as with USA and the eagle, a bird of prey, from the vulture family. The red dragon is the unseen king over all these divisions of these countries. The beast of the sea seen in Rev. Chapter 1-3 are the nations of the earth controlled by the dragon.

Notice the number of heads and horns on both the dragon and the beast of the sea. The wound on the dragons head is because of the judgment against the false system of religion, ad when they slaughtered the saints. Notice both the religious system and the dragon are wounded in the head, which means the dragon shall set up another church like the Catholic Church. The ten (10) horns represent the kings of the nations to receive the worship of man. At this point the deadly wound is healed Rev.13:11-18 followed by the two-horned beast from the bottom of hell. The prophet saw in a vision saw the dragon leap from the bottomless pit, through a grate under a shed, which covered it. The dragon appeared like a sheep with short horns, with ring-stricken hair, like a mule, but with cross-stripes

The Seven Kings (Rev 12:3 Rev.17:10) The Dragon Kingdom is the Earth and the seven divisions of the land sea and air in seven parts, and five (5) are fallen. The fall of the sixth (6th) was revealed by the prophets' vision of 1/4/79... and it was said that the devil was at last ditch stand, and his fall is at the deliverance time of the saints. The word "fall" in the vision brought us to the study of the Red Dragon's fall and its seven divisions of earth time is in the amount of 6066 years as a measuring rule of time.

1) The nation of Russia under the symbol of the Bear

The Russian Bear is a <u>national personification</u> for <u>Russia</u>, used in cartoons and articles at least since the 19th century, and relating alike to <u>Tsarist</u> Russia, the <u>Soviet Union</u> and the present post-Soviet Russia. The bear symbol and time zone was from the death of (the Garden of Eden) Able to the flood of Noah. <u>2nd Sam.17:8</u>, <u>Prov. 17:12</u>, and <u>Dan.7:5</u>

2) The nation of Great Britain under the symbol of the Lion

Great Britian's Lion. The <u>lion</u> is a common <u>charge</u> in <u>heraldry</u>. It traditionally symbolises bravery, valour, strength, and royalty, since traditionally, it is regarded as the king of beasts. As many <u>attitudes</u> (positions) now exist in heraldry as the heraldist's imagination can conjure, as a result of the ever-increasing need for differentiation, but very few of these were apparently known to medieval heralds. One distinction commonly made (especially among French heralds), although it may be of limited importance, is the distinction of lions in the walking positions as *leopards*. The following table summarizes the principal attitudes of heraldic lions:

The Lion symbol and time zone represents the Nations of Idolatry from the flood to the deliverance of the Jews from Babylon. <u>Dan.3:1-7</u>

3) The nation of Arabic Nation under the symbol of the Wolf

The Arabic Wolf, The *Epistle to the Son of the Wolf* is the last major work of the <u>Bahá'í Faith</u>, before his death in 1892. It is a letter written to a Muslim cleric, a violent opponent of the Bahá'ís who, along with his father (called by Bahá'u'lláh "the wolf"), also a Muslim cleric, had put to death a. From Babylon to the persecution of the Maccabees (<u>Daniel 2:16</u>) the evening wolf, <u>Hab.1:8</u>, the ravening wolf <u>Matt.7:15</u> and <u>Matt. 10</u> <u>chapter</u>. This is a characteristic of both the government and people of Arabic nations. <u>Ps.58:6</u>, <u>Jer.2:15</u>

4) The nation of USA under the symbol of the Vulture

The Vulture Bald Eagle is a <u>bird of prey</u> found in <u>North America</u>. It is the <u>national bird</u> and <u>symbol</u> of the <u>United States of America</u>. A time represented by the great corruption in the church and the invading kings, <u>Dan.11:31-32</u>. 490 years is divided between the wolf and the vulture. A time represented by the Greek worshiping various mythological gods. <u>Isa.34:14-15</u>

5) The nation of China under the symbol of the Serpent

China Serpent Serpent and dragons are legendary creatures in Chinese mythology and folklore Chinese, with mythic counterparts among Japanese, Korean, Vietnamese and Turkic dragons. In Chinese art, dragons are typically portrayed as long, scaled, serpentine creatures with four legs. The serpent from the days of Christ to the heavenly judgment when the devil was cast out into the bottomless pit, and the fall of five (5) previous kings of the dragon. Isa.14:29, Matt.23:33, Isa.27:1

6) The nation of Japan under the symbol of the Dog

The Japanese Raccoon Dog the tanuki, the animal carries historical and cultural significance in Japan. Traditionally, different areas of Japan would have different names for raccoon dogs as animals, which would be used to denote different animals in other parts of the country, however the official word in the standard Tokyo dialect is now "tanuki", a term that carries folkloric significance. It is also a common theme in Japanese art, especially in statuary. This time zone lasted a very short time Rev.12:12. A mad dog Jer.15:3. Vision of the prophet on 12/9/70 of the arrival of the dog (6th King) the Disintegrator representing a fall of morals, virtue and the rise sodomite sin total corruption and filth.

7) The nation of Spanish Nations under the symbol of the Frog

The frog represents the removal of human love, great deceit, the dark day of Armageddon Rev. 13th chapter, and the plagues of Rev.16:13-14
