Duck Feeding Concerns

Feeding ducks on Staats Lake may seem kind, but it can harm both the birds and the lake's ecosystem. Human foods like bread and crackers disrupt their natural diet, leading to poor nutrition, disease, and dependence on people. Artificial feeding also causes overcrowding, aggressive flocking, and excess waste, which fuels algae growth and lowers water quality. Allowing ducks to forage naturally keeps them healthier, helps maintain cleaner water, and preserves the balance of the ecosystem for all residents and wildlife to enjoy

Fall Shore Pruning

Each September, the vegetation between the lake path and the water is trimmed as part of our annual maintenance. This practice helps control plant growth, encourages healthy rejuvenation, protects lakeside wildlife, maintains community visibility, and helps manage HOA costs for homeowners and path users.

Lake Lights
