What you need the day of the road test:

- NYS Learner's Permit
- MV-278 - Pre-Licensing Course Completion Certificate
or
- MV-285 - Driver Education Completion Certificate
 - The MV-285 supersedes the MV-278. You don't need both
- MV-262 – Certification of Supervised Driving (if under 18 y/o)
 - The bottom part of the form **does not** have to be filled out
 - It can be added, but only the parent's signature is required

Other things to remember:

- **DO NOT** practice in or near the road test site area.
- The student **CANNOT** be behind the wheel when you pull up to the road test site.
- When you get to the road test site, you will get in line behind the other cars that are waiting. If you are the only one at the site, pull up to the green sign that says, "DMV Road Test Starts Here"
- You will not be given the results of the test at the site.
- When the road test is over, the examiner will give you a business card with a link to a website to check your results.
- Results are posted at the end of their shift and available at or around 6:00 PM

POSSESSION OF THIS CERTIFICATE DOES NOT NECESSARILY MEAN THAT YOU ARE READY TO TAKE A ROAD TEST. YOUR TRAINING SHOULD BE SUPPLEMENTED WITH ADDITIONAL BEHIND-THE-WHEEL DRIVING EXPERIENCE.

If you have a **junior learner permit** and:

- if you are age 16 at the time of your road test, present this completed MV-285 and a completed MV-262 (Certification of Supervised Driving) to the Motor Vehicle License Examiner at the road test. If you pass the skills test, and are otherwise eligible for a license, you will be issued a Class DJ or MJ license.
- if you are age 17 at the time of your road test, present this completed MV-285 and a completed MV-262 (Certificate of Supervised Driving) to the Motor Vehicle License Examiner at the road test. If you pass the skills test, and are otherwise eligible for a license, you will be issued a Class D or M license.

If you have a **junior driver license** (class DJ or MJ) you can obtain "senior" driving privileges (class D or M) at age seventeen by presenting this certificate with a completed license application (form MV-44) at any Motor Vehicles office. However, a Class D or M license does not allow you to supervise a learning driver; supervising drivers must be at least age **21**.

This certificate is valid for two years from the original date it is issued.

The number of hours driven with supervision in a certified Driver Education Course is considered part of the required 50 hours and can be certified on the back of this form.

NOTE TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A JUNIOR DRIVER: You can remove the consent you gave when the junior driver described above submitted an application for a driver permit or driver license. To cancel the junior driver's class DJ or MJ permit or driver license, complete form MV-1W (Withdrawal of Consent) and submit the form to DMV.

I understand that falsifying any information on this certification may be a crime (felony or misdemeanor), punishable by a fine, imprisonment, or both.
