COMMUNITY PARK REGULATIONS

WE HAVE RECEIVED NUMEROUS **COMPLAINTS OF DOG FECES IN** THE PARK THAT HAVE NOT BEEN CLEANED UP BY THEIR OWNER.

ADDITIONAL SIGNS HAVE BEEN POSTED TO STATE THAT DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARK. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO WALK YOUR DOG, GATEWAY PARK DOWN THE STREET IS DOG FRIENDLY.

May 9, 1868

"Galena. - Among the enterprizing [sic] merchants of Galena, Kent county, we know of none that can excell [sic] Mr. E.W. Purnell. His 'Galena Cash Store' has now become firmly established, while the constantly increasing patronage which he receives is ample evidence of the popularity of his system of doing business."

March 3, 1869.

Messrs. Editors: -- A correspondent stated

in your paper, some two years since, that 'Galena was getting more like New York every day,' which at the time was thought to be an idle assertion, but really, Messrs. Editors, our town is rapidly improving. Our prince of merchants, Jeremiah Peacock, is adding another commodious store house to his row, which will be ready for occupancy in a short time. E. W. Purnell, who some two years since, rented a sore house here, and who has advertised liberally, has so increased and prospered in business as to require more room. He has recently purchased from P. Medders, Esq., a lot fronting forty feet on street to Georgetown, running back some three hundred feet, for seven hundred dollars, on which he intends erecting a store house twenty-five by sixty feet. Wm. T. Betton, Esq., whom everybody likes, has fitted up a very neat store house in Georgetown, where, we understand, he will soon open a general business. Thos. H. Horsey, his gentlemanly clerk, succeeds him in Galena; no doubt both will do well. Mr. B. is not 'penny wise and pound foolish;' he advertises in county papers, which, there is no use talking, will increase business, and make fortunes for those who practise [sic] it.

June 10, 1871 p3

"Galena. - A Galena correspondent of the Cecil Whig, furnishes the following items:

- •Building Association. The Galena Building Association, made a sale of money, on Tuesday evening last, at 17 per cent premium.
- Library. -The Galena Library has recently been increased by the addition of a number of choice books. This library is said to be the best on the Eastern Shore."
- •Religious. Regular service is being held by Dr. Trapier, (Episcopal) in our Town Hall.

Voting will open at 9:00 AM and close at 6:00 PM.


All voting will take place at the Town Hall.


The ballot will have elections for 1 Mayor seat and 2 Council Member seats, both for two (2) year terms.

PAVILION RENTAL

If you are renting the pavilion, please be aware of the rules when you are finished with your event.

It will be the responsibility of the party renting the pavilion and facilities to assure that they are cleaned prior to departure from the park area.

No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the park without written permission of the Mayor and Council.

The only vehicles allowed into the immediate park area will be those on Town business unless authorized by the Mayor or an authorized representative.

No bicycles, go-carts, motorized, or any similar type vehicles will be allowed in the park. However, bicycles may be in designated bicycle racks or the rack area. The only other exception to this will be ADA manual or motorized equipment.

TOWN MEETINGS

- Mayor & Council meets the first Monday of each month. Meetings are open to the public.
- The Planning & Zoning Committee meets on the last Monday of each month as needed.
- The Park and Tree Committee meets monthly on the third Tuesday at 6pm.
- The town parks and restroom are open from dawn until dusk.
- The pavilion at the community park is available for rental at a reasonable fee. If you are interested in renting, a rental form can be found on our website at
