Now, Therefore, in consideration of the foregoing premises, it is hereby agreed to by and between Tom/Liberty Equestrian Center, LLC/Property owner and Guest as follows:

1. Guest hereby acknowledges and agrees that the activities, which Guest plans to engage in, are or may be dangerous and may involve risks of injury or death, and/or property damage, and that Tom/Liberty Equestrian Center, LLC/Property Owner assumes NO responsibility for such activities.

4. By signing this, you give us permission to call 911 in case of an emergency.

***Notice: A person who is engaged for compensation in the rental or equines or equine equipment or tack or in the instruction of a person in the riding of driving of an equine or in being a passenger upon an equine is not liable for the injury or death or a person involved in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, as defined in section 895.481(1) (e) of the Wisconsin State Statutes.
