

Update for Melvich Community Council: 20th January 2022





Progress since last Community Council meeting:


- First AGM held (23rd November 2021).
- Outputs from Melvich community hub specification workshop plus other information received from other individuals/groups collated.
- Information on specification aspects for feedback compiled and distributed to community.
- Surface at old hall site compacted with additional hard core. Christmas tree erected for festive period.
- Community growing project progressing ordering various items for use on the site of the former village hall.
- Dissolution of Melvich Village Hall Association completed.
- Funding secured for purchase of land adjacent to former village hall.
- Boundaries of land for purchase agreed & delineated.





Work planned in coming months:

- Complete legal process to transfer land adjacent to the former village hall (completion expected end 03/2022).
- Perform consultation on community asset transfer of public toilets then progress with evidence.
- Compile feedback on specification aspects of new facility from our community (closing date for responses extended to 31st January 2022).
- Commence community growing project on site of former village hall (ready for Spring 2022).
- Develop specification for tendering design phase of new facility (considering using RIBA stages 0-6).
