



## Community Asset Transfer of the Public Toilets at Melvich, Sutherland KW14 7YJ

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Highland Council currently own and operate the public toilets in Melvich. The availability of, and access to, clean private public toilets are essential for both locals and visitors.

As part of the design of the Melvich Community Hub we are considering incorporating new public toilet facilities that meet modern standards and are suitable for use by persons of all abilities. If public access toilets are incorporated into the hub a portion will be open to the public and some reserved for hall users. In the case of a large event the entire toilet facility would be opened up for use.

There are costs associated with providing public toilet facilities (such as employing a cleaner for the facilities) however there are also opportunities to have these costs offset by users or grant funded. Melvich Community SCIO are keen to ensure that suitable public toilet provision is available in Melvich. We have expressed interest to Highland Council for a community asset transfer of the Melvich public toilets. Our intent (if supported by our community and visitors) is to incorporate the public toilets into our building. Once the new toilets are functioning, then we would take formal ownership of the existing toilets and demolish them.
