Melvich Community Hub project

- No significant change.
- Community Asset Transfer request for Melvich Public toilets going through due process (Application submitted 16/05/2022).
- Working to deliver outputs required for RIBA Stage 1. This stage should be complete ~ Summer 2023.
- Once RIBA Stage 1 is complete then we will be preparing / issuing an invitation to tender (ITT) for RIBA Stages 2-4 to provide updated cost comparisons and better demonstrate value for money. ITT likely to be issued in ~Autumn 2023.




Portskerra Play Park

- Community Asset Transfer (CAT) application submitted for Portskerra Play Park on 15/11/2022. Not yet shown on Highland Council CAT website page (20/06/2023). Process flowchart shows that Highland Council have 6 months to complete the "Assessment and Consideration" stage from submission of the CAT request.
- Had some communication from Phil Tomalin (HC Ward Manager) on this topic and now have a copy of the title deeds for this area of land. Due to a pre-emption on the land, likely to be seeking a long term lease of the land rather than outright ownership. In progress.
- Work on Invitation to tender (ITT) for play park equipment ON HOLD until uncertainties in lease/ownership issue resolved.




Portskerra Play Park

Community Action Plan

- As mentioned previously, preferred independent consultant selected to perform the work had been selected for Melvich Community Council area.
- Caithness West CC, Strathy and Armadale CC and Bettyhill, Strathnaver and Altnaharra CC been added in as additional scope on our contract. Revised pricing received for delivery of CAPs for the 4 CC areas. Pricing further reviewed upon examination of additional efficiency opportunities.
- Questions from Local Energy Scotland and Scottish Government responded to in relation to grant funding application to ensure value for money from this work.
- Received notification that our grant funding application for this work has been approved.
- Formal contract award will be made as soon as grant award letter for the CAP is received.
- Programme for delivery of the CAP will be finalised after grant award letter received.
