THE BEUGRE & WILSON FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

DESCRIPTION

The Beugre & Wilson Foundation Scholarship is a highly selective, fully funded scholarship for exceptional, Pell-eligible, high school seniors. Starting in 2018, each year the scholarship will be awarded to two student leaders with the intent of promoting their academic excellence through college graduation and providing them the opportunity to reach their full potential.

A WARD

Scholars will receive funding for the full cost of attendance* that is not already covered by other financial aid and the expected family contribution, as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), or the methodology used by a Scholar's college or university. Scholarship amount TBD by GPA, college acceptance; type of educational institution; and total cost.

*Cost of attendance includes tuition, fees, room, board, books, transportation, and other personal costs.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- A high school senior
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)
- Submit application, transcript and career plan in the form of a 1500-word essay to beugreandwilsonfoundation@gmail.com

Additionally, a student must plan to enroll full-time, in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university.

*NOTE: BEUGRE & WILSON FOUNDATION awarded over \$90,000 in donations, grants, and scholarships last year.

PGMAES RECEIVE AS YOU ACHIEVE GRANT A & B

DESCRIPTION

The PGMAES Receive As You Achieve Grant is offered to high school seniors and adult learners with the intent of promoting their academic excellence through post-secondary, education graduation; to provide them the opportunity to reach their full potential.

A WARD

Students will receive funding to assist with the cost of education. Financial assistance can be received by check or automatic deposit to checking or savings account. Grants of \$1,000 to \$3,000 will be awarded with consideration to the type of educational institution and level of degree program.

*Funds may be use for tuition, fees, room, board, books, transportation, and other personal expenses.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- A high school senior or adult student
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) **-FOR GRANT "B" ONLY-**
- Submit application and transcript to drcwilson@pgmaes.org

Additionally, a student must plan to enroll full-time, in a two-year or four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university; vocational or trade school.

PGMAES HIGH SCHOOL/COLLEGE GRADUATE GRANT

DESCRIPTION

The PGMAES High School/College Graduate Grant is presented to high school seniors and adults learners congratulate them for completing their educational program.

A WARD

Students will receive a monetary gift as a one-time disbursement. Awards can be received by check or automatic deposit to checking or savings account. Grant of \$250 to \$2,000 will be awarded with consideration to the degree program. Grants are available on a first come first serve basis.

*Funds may be use for future tuition, fees, room, board, books, and transportation, personal expenses or to celebrate.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- Current high school graduate or college graduate
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- No minimum cumulative weighted GPA required
- Submit application to drcwilson@pgmaes.org

Students will receive funding to assist with the cost of education. Financial assistance can be received by check or automatic deposit to checking or savings account. Grant of \$200 to \$500 will be awarded to students, with the highest GPAs, varying by grade level.

*Funds may be use for tuition, fees, room, board, books, transportation, and other personal expenses.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- A junior-high/middle or high school student
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)
- Submit application and transcript to intellectual communication@gmail.com

YCM PRIMARY GRADUATION GRANT

DESCRIPTION

The YCM Primary Graduation Grant is offered to junior-high/middle, and high school graduates with the intent of promoting their academic excellence through rewarding secondary graduation and encouraging post-secondary education to provide them the opportunity to reach their full potential.

A WARD

Students will receive funding to assist with the cost of education. Financial assistance can be received by check or automatic deposit to checking or savings account. Grants of \$100 to \$300 will be awarded to graduates on a first come first serve basis.

*Funds may be use for tuition, fees, room, board, books, transportation, and other personal expenses.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- A recent junior-high/middle or high school graduate
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- No minimum cumulative weighted GPA required
