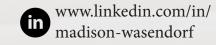

Wayfinding is an essential part of this specific typology. The people utilizing this facility have many mental health issues, and ages range from 21 and older. Some users may suffer from memory loss. Easily finding their way around the building and feeling independence as they travel to their classroom or activity room is essential. That is why two lines are starting in the lobby on each hallway leading back to the Education & Activity section of the facility. One line is green & the other blue. These lines lead users to classrooms or activity rooms and coordinate with their schedule to guide where they are supposed to be at each part of the day. This system teaches critical skills and grows their independence.

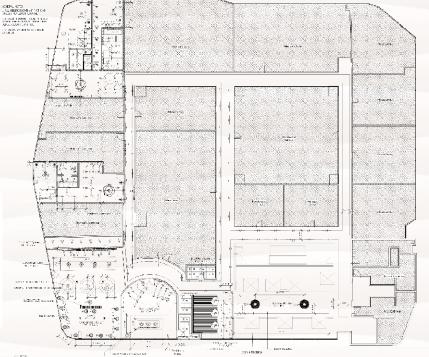






























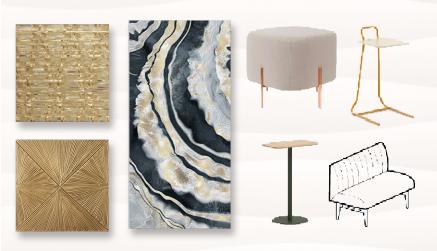

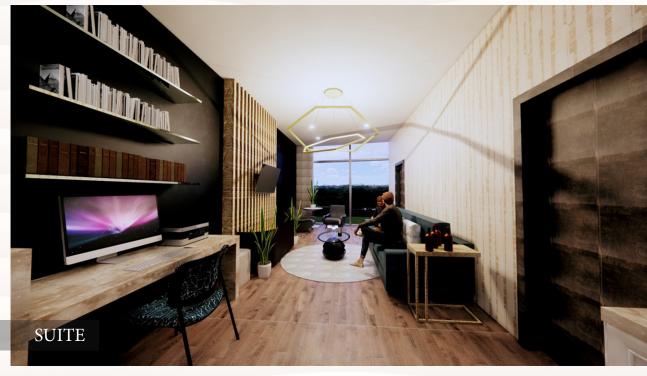

it is important to provide adequate acoustical & visual privacy barriers in open office spaces to give the employees the privacy they need

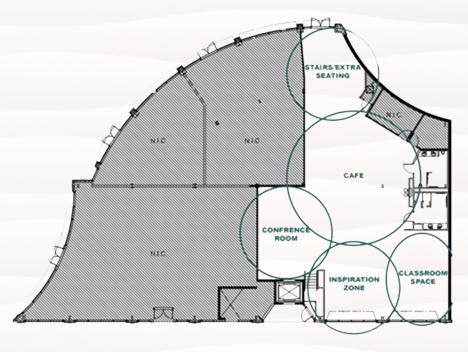
Bubble Diagram-First floor

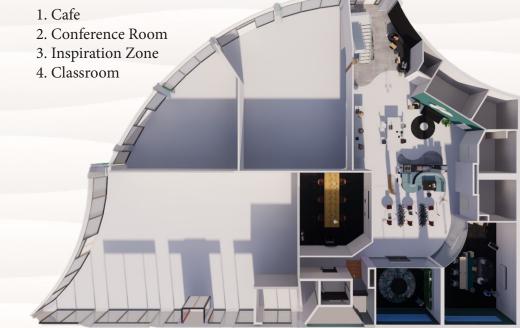


Bubble Diagram-Second Floor

••••• The goal of this design was to create a container home out of six total containers. Three 8' x 20' containers and three 8' x 40' containers.

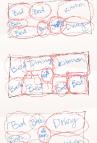

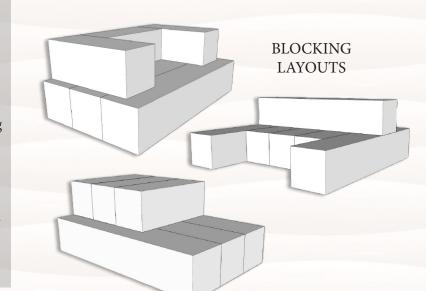
