Monthly rent is based on the level of personal service needs for each resident. Increases in the level of care are subject to change month to month, without notice as they are based on the resident's current care needs. These needs are identified in the resident's individual service plan. Each resident will be given a notice for any facility wide rate increase. When two people are renting an apartment, the resident with the higher level of care pays at the regular apartment price for that level of care. The resident with the lower level of care is priced at the second person rate.

The resident's level of care is determined after a thorough evaluation, which determines which services will be performed for the resident, the staff involved and the complexity of the services.

This initial evaluation creates an individual service plan for the resident and assigns a total number of points which determines the level of care the resident will be at. The individual service plan is updated 30 -days after initial move in, quarterly and as needed due to the resident's current care needs.

## Additional Move-In Fees:

~ Community Fee: $\$ 2,500$
and The first half is due upon request of evaluation to proceed with the admission process. If resident does not move in after evaluation is completed, $\$ 500$ is refundable. The remaining $\$ 750$ is non-refundable and will be applied to the cost of the evaluation and initial admission processing.
~ Room Hold: $\$ 50$ per day
