#### Schedule

## Registration and course fees – how to pay

Registration is required to secure you place in the masterclasses.  
The fee for the vocal masterclasses is 100euro.

## Location of the Venue

Do not confuse the SALON Razumovsky with Palais Razumofsky. The SALON is located very near to the Belvedere Palace. You can access it by trams 0 and D, or the S-Bahn. We will be supplying unlimited wifi at the venue.
