Book Background: MOON (Margaret Olive O’Brian Newsome) is about a woman in her midlife who is not coping well with divorce from her high school sweetheart and estrangement from her daughter. Looking in the mirror, she no longer sees the woman she was but someone she doesn’t recognize. She served an eviction notice on her 45th birthday, and she now has 30 days to figure out who she is, what she wants, and how to get there. Riveting and compelling, Moon is the story of a tired and worn-out soul who, just before giving up in despair, tries one last thing. And that thing seems to be the ticket out of her broken-down life. Moon slowly rises from the ashes of self-pity to embrace a transformation that comes to her in fits and starts but comes nonetheless. She must confront her former husband, find a way to win back her prodigal daughter, learn to trust old friends and new ones, and pray to God that the Family won’t demand back the house of her dreams-the first of a trilogy.
