All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary)

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)		£2720
<i>This is a funeral with family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend the burial or cremation.</i>		
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements		£630
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises) into the funeral directors care		£305
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's Chapel of Rest		£395
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered wood with matching mouldings, gold effect handles and engraved name plate		£485
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)		£25
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or Crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral directors premises) in a hearse or appropriate vehicle		£880

UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
<i>This is a funeral we are family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</i>	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	Not Offered
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus cremation fee)	£2268.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an attended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup> In this local area the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: <i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/ replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	£951 - £1178
For an attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b> . <sup>2</sup> In this local area the typical cost of the cremation fee for local residents is:	£655 - £1007
