#### THE 2025 NATIONAL JUBILEE WALKING PILGRIMAGE OF HOPE

The Pilgrimage of Hope is a national walking pilgrimage for England and Wales with four main Ways converging at the Cathedral of St Barnabas, Nottingham, on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2025, the eve of the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. It is an initiative of the Hearts in Search of God project. The Ways start at the Catholic cathedrals in Cardiff, Leeds, Norwich and London and will bless our nations with a Sign of the Cross. The routes use established hiking routes and are off road as much as possible. A small group of 'perpetual pilgrims' will walk the full distance of each Way, with up to 20 day pilgrims joining for day stages.

#### ARCHDIOCESAN SAFEGUARDING TEAM

The Archdiocesan Safegaurding Team will be holding TWO DBS clinics for anyone who requires a DBS for the first time, anyone needing to renew their DBS information, those who need further information, or clarify their DBS status and for those who are unsure whether they are required to have a DBS for the role they carry out.

Roles for which DBS's are generally required include. Adult Altar servers (18+). Altar Server Chaperone, Sacristan, Extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist (Visiting housebound etc.), Children's liturgy, Childrens Catechists (FHC & Confirmation). SVP members who give lists or visit, Parish Visitors to housebound/sick, parish lift providers to parishioners etc. Parish safeguarding Reps, Clergy (seminarians, proests and deacons), Bereavement support volunteers, Youth group workers, Music/choir groupos (where children attend without parent/guardians). The clinics will be held in the Father Carroll Centre, St Illtyd's, Dowlais on TUESDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> JULY FROM 5.00 pm to 7.00pm AND SATURDAY 2<sup>nd</sup> AUGUST from 10.00am to 12.30pm. Please be sure to bring a minimum of THREE ID documenrs with you.

e.g. Passport, Driving licence, proof of address, a letter dated within the last three months, e.g. Utility Bill, Bank Statement or NHS Letter Also you will need to bring your last Council tax letter.

Proof of name changes e.g. Marriage Certificate, Decree Absolute or Deed Poll.
