

2025 WE AS ONE LANGUAGE CAMP STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Stipends are provided on a first-come, first-serve basis for students in grades K-8th (2025-2026 school year) to attend We As One Camps in the summer of 2025.

Who is eligible?

Eligible students must be:

- A current Minnesota resident eligible for free or reduced priced lunches
- Student whose incoming grades are Kindergarten through 8th in fall 2025
- Student who currently attends or plans to attend a Chinese/Spanish/Hmong language school/program in fall 2025, or from heritage families
- Eligibility also depends on remaining funds available

What does the scholarship cover?

- The scholarship will cover the full cost of the summer camp program fee (\$310 per week per student, 9:30am-3:30pm).
- The scholarship will NOT cover the cost of Extended Day (8:30am-9:30am and 3:30pm-4:30pm). To register for Extended Day, families must pay the cost of the program (\$70 per week per student).
- The scholarship will NOT cover transportation and food costs. Families must arrange their own transportation and prepare a lunch, snack and water bottle for students on a daily basis.

What is the Application Process?

- You will first need to provide We As One Camp with up-to-date documentation from a school/district official, or 2024 household income tax document that proves you are income eligible for free or reduced price lunches.  <u>Registration</u> website page, and fill out the registration form for your child(ren).
- A summer camp staff will reach out and confirm your registration after the eligibility document and camp registration form are both received and verified.
