Participation:

Greenie Weenie is intended for riders and horses new to dressage.

Medium Walk:

A free, regular, unconstrained walk of moderate lengthening where horse's hind feet touch the ground in front of footprints of the forefeet.

Free Walk:

A gait of relaxation in which the horse is allowed complete freedom to lower and stretch out his head and neck.

Comments:

Horses should be ridden on a light but steady contact. Greater importance should be placed upon preparation, correctness and quality of the movements rather than the gaits of the horse and exact execution of the movements at a specific marker.

REQUIREMENTS

Medium Walk Free Walk 20 Meter Circle Halt through Walk

PURPOSE: To introduce the rider and/or horse to the dressage arena and the sport of dressage. To show understanding of riding the horse forward with a steady tempo into an elastic contact with independent, steady hands and a correctly balanced seat. To show proper geometry of figures in the arena with correct bend (corners and circles).
