

# PA DEP Violations Highlights

Only a fraction of known incidents  
Violation Type: Environmental Health & Safety

## Hazardous Waste

1993

- Containers of hazardous waste are not managed to prevent leaks and stored longer than 90 days (multiple times).
- Mismanagement of hazardous waste (multiple times).
- Wastes placed in containers not properly marked and labeled or not in tanks meeting requirements.
- Preparedness, Prevention and Contingency Plan not developed and implemented.

## Hazardous Waste

- Containers or tanks not managed and stored longer than 90 days (multiple times).

## Air Quality

- Construction, Modification, Reactivation and Operation of Sources, Operating Permits (multiple times).
- Failure to comply with the submittal of monitoring and related recordkeeping and reporting requirements (multiple times).

2001

## Hazardous Waste

- Containers of hazardous waste are not closed during storage.
- Containers or tanks not managed and stored longer than 90 days.

2006

## Hazardous Waste

- Preparedness, Prevention and Contingency Plan not developed and implemented.

2008

## Air Quality

- Reporting of Sources, Emission statements. Failure to submit emission statements.
- Construction, Modification, Reactivation and Operation of Sources, Operating Permits.
- Failure to comply with the submittal of monitoring and related recordkeeping and reporting requirements.

2017

## DEP Site Survey

- Cobalt and Selenium were identified above the non-residential statewide health standard in three areas of concern.
- Two wells at the center of the site contained concentrations of aluminum, iron, lead, and manganese above the non-residential statewide health standard

2020

## Building Demolished

- The former Specialty Records/WEA/Cinram/Technicolor facility was demolished, and the new Canpack facility was constructed over areas where buried drums and MOCs had previously been identified.
