

## ATTENDEE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. Event Registration:

- All participants must register for the event through the official website or by purchasing a ticket from designated platforms.
- Registrations are transferable to another person. Badge ID must be collected by the registered badge pick up person.
- Registrations are non-refundable, except in cases of event cancellation or rescheduling at the discretion of the organizers.
- Participants must provide accurate and up-to-date information during registration, including contact details and any special requirements. Registration can be made at this link once tickets have been purchased.

- Any attendee under the age of 18 must be declared by an adult at the door. Attendees under 18 receive a special band that ensures that they are treated like minors.

### 2. Event Admission:

- Admission to the event is subject to presentation of a valid registration confirmation and ticket.
- Entry may be denied to individuals without proper registration or those found violating event policies.
- Entry may be denied to individuals with badges or wristbands that have evidently been tampered with.
- The organizers reserve the right to refuse admission or remove individuals from the event premises for disruptive behavior or non-compliance with event rules.

### 3. Code of Conduct:

- All attendees must adhere to the event's code of conduct, which prohibits harassment, discrimination, bullying, or any other form of inappropriate behavior.
- Costumes, attire, and props must comply with safety guidelines set by the organizers. Real katanas, knives or guns are **NOT** permitted on premises.
- Any behavior deemed offensive, disruptive, or threatening by the organizers or security personnel will result in immediate expulsion from the event without refund.

### 4. Liability and Responsibility:

- The organizers are not liable for any loss, injury, or damage to personal property incurred during the event, including but not limited to theft, accidents, or acts of nature.
- Participants are responsible for their own safety and well-being while attending the event and should exercise caution and common sense at all times.
- Minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult guardian throughout the event.

## **5. Photography and Media Release:**

- By attending the event, participants grant the organizers permission to use their likeness, voice, and image captured during the event for promotional and marketing purposes.
