

Panel and Workshop Participation Agreement

By agreeing to participate as a panelist or facilitator or facilitator at GOM CON or THE GEEK OUT, hereafter referred to as "The Convention," panelist or facilitators and facilitators agree to abide by the terms and conditions outlined herein.

Panel and Workshop Content and Conduct

1. Panelists or facilitators are responsible for creating and presenting content that is appropriate for a diverse audience of anime enthusiasts.
2. Age for intended audience should be expressly stated. NSFW content is allowed, but attendees should know exactly what to expect when registering for a panel and its age appropriateness.
3. Panels must adhere to The Convention's guidelines regarding content, including but not limited to language, themes, and subject matter.
4. Panelists or facilitators must conduct themselves in a professional manner and refrain from engaging in behavior that may be deemed offensive, discriminatory, or disruptive.

Compliance with Convention Policies

1. Panelists or facilitators must comply with all convention policies and guidelines, including those related to harassment, discrimination, and code of conduct.
2. Panelists or facilitators are expected to familiarize themselves with the Convention's policies and ensure that their panels adhere to these standards.

Timeliness and Preparedness

1. Panelists or facilitators must arrive on time and adequately prepared for their scheduled panel sessions.
2. Late arrivals or unpreparedness may result in the cancellation or rescheduling of the panel at the discretion of The Convention organizers.

Equipment and Technical Requirements

1. Equipment included in the room are tables, 40 chairs, microphones, and a projector.
2. Panelist or facilitators must provide any necessary equipment or materials for their panel presentations, including laptops, and other audiovisual aids.
3. Technical requirements must be communicated to the Convention organizers in advance to ensure compatibility with the venue's facilities.

Intellectual Property Rights

1. Panelists or facilitators retain all intellectual property rights to their panel content, including any materials or presentations created for the Convention.
2. The Convention reserves the right to record, photograph, or livestream panel sessions for promotional or archival purposes with prior consent from the panelist or facilitator.

Compensation and Expenses:

1. Panelists or facilitators are not entitled to monetary compensation for their participation in the Convention.
2. Any expenses incurred by panelist or facilitator, including travel, accommodation, or materials, are the sole responsibility of the panelist or facilitators and will not be reimbursed by the Convention.
3. Panelist or facilitators are entitled to 2 complimentary standard badges

Termination of Agreement:

1. The Convention organizers reserve the right to terminate this agreement and remove panelists or facilitators from their scheduled sessions for violations of these terms and conditions or for any other reason deemed necessary.
2. In the event of termination, panelists or facilitators will not be entitled to compensation or reimbursement for any expenses incurred.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of The Bahamas, and any disputes arising from or related to this agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in The Bahamas.

By participating as a panelist or facilitator at The Convention, panelists or facilitators acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to abide by these terms and conditions outlined by The Convention organizers.
