

# First Aid for Mental Health (Level 2)

Duration: 1 day

Formats: Face-to-face

This 1-Day course covers the content of the Level 1 course but also expands on the effects of drugs and alcohol, incorporates the First Aid for Mental Health Action Plan and covers ways in which a positive mental health culture can be supported within a workplace.

### Who is it for?

This course is particularly suitable for those who want to:

- gain a deeper understanding of mental health issues
- be able to help build a positive mental health culture
- be a point of contact for positive mental health within your organisation
- gain an understanding of the effects of drugs and alcohol on mental health.

#### What does it include?

- Defining mental health
- Understanding the stigma around mental health
- Identifying factors that impact mental health
- Understanding the role of first aider for mental health
- Outline advice that should be provided to a person suffering from a suspected mental health condition
- Know when to contact the emergency services in respect of first aid for mental health
- Identify signs of stress
- Be able to state how stress can be managed
- Identify signs and symptoms for depression, anxiety, psychosis, eating disorders, suicide & self-harm
- State the potential effects of alcohol and drug abuse on a person's mental health
- Demonstrate the application of the first aid action plan for mental health
- Providing a positive mental health culture in the workplace and know how to implement it.

#### Assessment

This RQF qualification is assessed through a multiple choice test paper and practical demonstration of the first aid for mental health action plan.



Candidates who pass the assessment will earn a Level 2 Award in First Aid for Mental Health.
