**LIMA AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION REPORT:** Thornton gave the latest report for the Lima Area Community Foundation.

**NEW BUSINESS AND ACTION TAKEN:**

1. A motion by Wilson, seconded by Pulley, to approve the consent agenda. No public comment. Bernard aye, Pulley aye, Sutton aye, Wilson aye. Motion carried unanimously.
2. After discussion, a motion by Wilson, seconded by Sutton, to approve the appointment of Don Story as maintenance employee. No public comment. Bernard aye, Pulley aye, Sutton aye, Wilson aye. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Discussion regarding junk vehicles and solid waste. Pulley has been working with Tom Wagenknecht at the county on these issues. Wilson advised he is on the solid waste board and they are trying to come up with solutions for the Dell dump. Pulley recommends a letter be drafted and sent to attorney for junk vehicle and other enforcement. Wilson advised the next solid waste board meeting is 11/8.

6. A motion by Wilson, seconded by Sutton, to approve Resolution 2025-8, Public Comment Guidelines. Public comment given by Marriott. Bernard aye, Pulley aye, Sutton aye, Wilson aye. Motion carried unanimously.
7. After discussion, a motion by Sutton, seconded by Pulley, to accept the water agreements as drafted and send to the property owners. No public comment. Bernard aye, Pulley aye, Sutton aye, Wilson aye. Motion carried unanimously.
8. Discussion regarding status of donated water pump. Wilson advised two people will be measuring it and checking it out to determine if it may be utilized on a fire vehicle.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** Mayor Olsen advised he has received complaints regarding speeding in town and has spoken to the County Commissioners who said they would be speaking to the Sheriff's Office. Bernard believes the town should send monthly reports with the statistics from the radar speed signs to the county. Public comment given by Marriott. Wilson advised the question of whether the county would be open to housing the Women's State Prison (which was a topic at the last County Commissioner's meeting) was not received well and likely not happening.

Wilson advised the business utilizing some railroad property has a lease with the railroad to do so.
