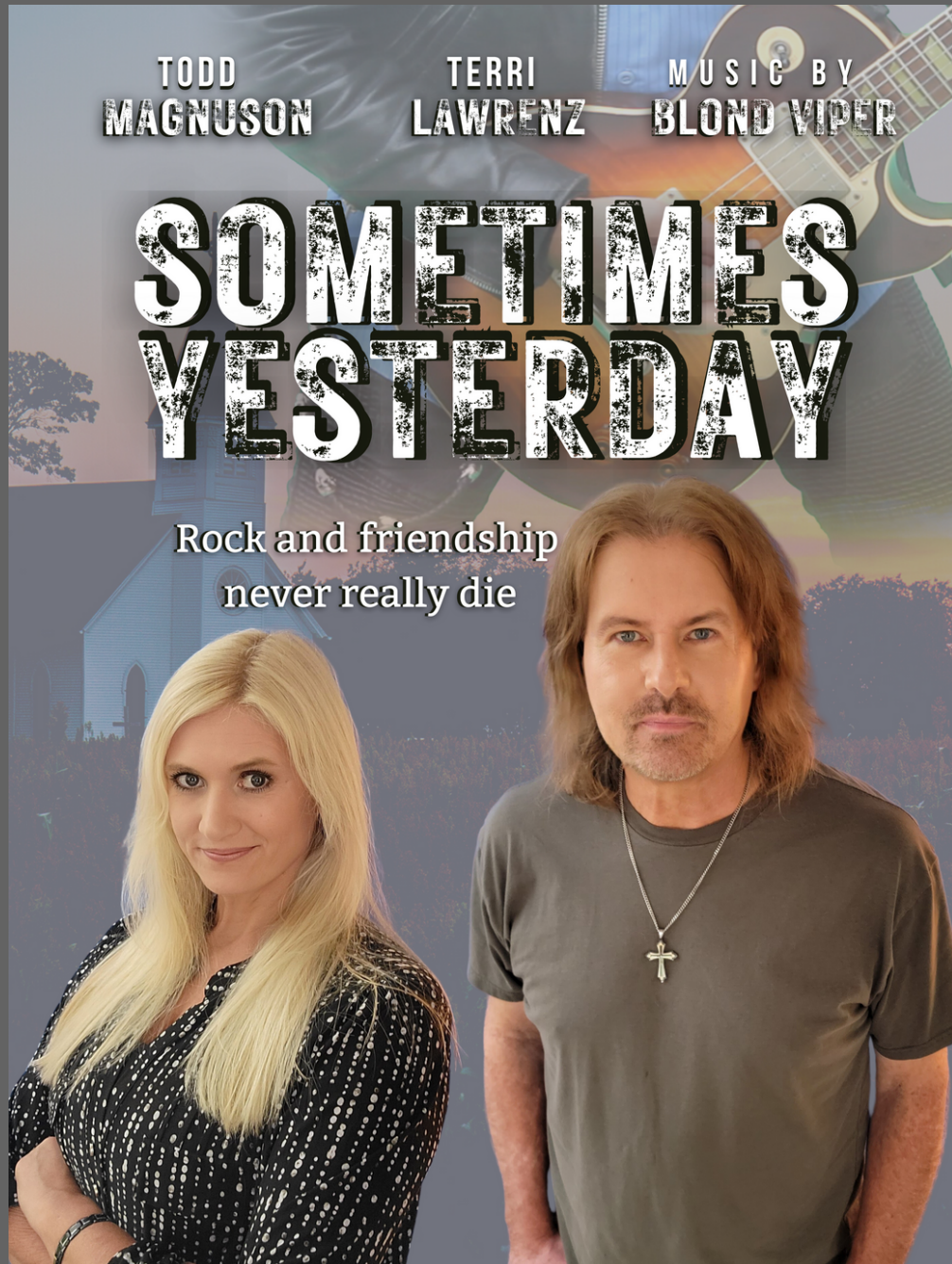


THEY'RE BACK!

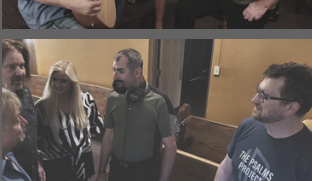
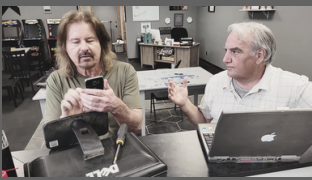
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**AWARD-WINNING SOUTH DAKOTA BASED FILM
SLATED FOR INTERNATIONAL RELEASE**



Todd Magnuson and Terri Lawrenz, best known for the television series *Nature Adventures with Terri and Todd*, have utilized two of their other interests; music and movie-making, to create a new feature-length film, *Sometimes Yesterday*.

Sometimes Yesterday is a modern-day musical drama about a terminally ill rock musician who develops an unlikely friendship with a church choir director. She helps him find a band to record his songs, and along the way they learn the true meaning of love.

During the Covid pandemic, TV production was shut down. As a result, they formed the band Blond Viper. "Since there wasn't much to do, Todd started writing and finishing some songs he started before *Nature Adventures*", stated Lawrenz. Magnuson added, "Terri has a beautiful singing voice. What started as 'just for fun', turned into a serious project".

Magnuson thought making a film would be a great way to remind the masses that new original rock is not gone. Their previous production background on various TV projects could make his vision a reality.

They brought Sioux Falls guitar-legend Eldon Fisher into the mix, and together fine tuned the music into a mix of classic, hard rock and ballads. With the addition of drummer Rich Dahl, they have completed 2 full studio albums.

Fisher said "Almost daily we hear from people saying how much they like our style, and how they miss that rock sound from the 70's and 80's." Lawrenz added, "We not only wanted to showcase Blond Viper in a unique way, but also wanted it known that music like ours is still being made, and that rock is still alive."

Sometimes Yesterday was 100% South Dakota made, with all actors and crew being from the state. It was also completely filmed in SD as well, shot in Sioux Falls, Hartford, Watertown, and Trent.

The film has won 9 awards for best original song/score at film festivals, including the Europe Independent Movie Festival and the Naples Film Awards in Italy. In fact, 40% of the sales of Blond Vipers albums are from Europe. "I'm glad we can give people overseas a chance to get a peak at what life is really like in South Dakota" said Lawrenz. "It's not very often that viewers worldwide get an accurate depiction."
