Daniel Island Neighborhood Association (DINA) Key points-11/08/23

** Denotes DI area and points of interest

- 2008 One Cent Sales Tax Program
 - **Clements Ferry Road, Phase 1/\$46.1M-4.1 miles of 4 lane road with medians, turn lanes, signalized intersections. Complete
 - **Clements Ferry Road, Phase 1/Multi-use path-3.7 miles of a multi-use path from Royal Assembly Drive to Forrest Drive. ROW acquisition under way. An engineering firm has been attained to revise the plans and bid out for construction.
- 2014 One Cent Sales Tax Program
 - * **Clements Ferry Road, Phase 2/\$77.4M-4.5 miles of 4 lane roads with medians, turn lanes, sidewalks, MUP, signalized intersections, bridge replacements, and major utility relocations. NTP 12/14/20, Completion date 11/30/24.
 - * **DI Roundabout/\$2M-Intersection improvement at Daniel Island Dr. and Seven Farms Dr. Complete
- 2022 One Cent Sales Tax Referendum/Estimated collection \$587M
 - Projects will include;
 - Capacity Projects / **Intersection Improvements / Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities
 - **Major and Local resurfacing / Unpaved Road Improvements / **Greenbelt Preservation NOTE: **Proposed projects on DI
 - **Roundabout at River Landing Dr. & Seven Farms Dr.
 - **Resurfacing Roads
 - Rivers Reach Drive improvements
 - Clements Ferry Road, Phase 1/Multi-use path
- SCDOT Projects
 - > Includes Interchange, Resurfacing, Preservation, Bridge Replacements, Widening and Safety Improvements:
 - **Cainhoy Road resurfacing/Clements Ferry Road to Hagan Avenue (Nucor entrance)-4.8 miles /\$2.6M-completion 07/31/23
 - * **Cainhoy Road mitigation and resurfacing/Hagan Avenue to SC 41 (8.21 miles) /\$4.5M-contract awarded 11/22
 - * **I-526 East Widening from Rivers Avenue to US 17/\$4B
 - I-526 West Widening from Rivers Avenue to Paul Cantrell/\$3B
- CTC road resurfacing
 - * **Seven Farms Dr. overlay / \$560K-completed
 - **Seven Farms Dr. crosswalk improvements / \$190K-completed NOTE: Funded by the City of CHS
 - **Daniel Island Dr. resurfacing/Fairchild Street to the roundabout at Sevens Farms Drive/Complete NOTE: Area stopped short because of bridge replacement over Beresford Creek
- Other projects
 - **Bridge replacement on Daniel Island Dr. at Beresford Creek Note: Managed by the City of Charleston
- Capital Projects
 - **DI Library Parking Lot Expansion/Expand existing parking lot to add an additional 56 parking spaces. Note: Budgeted \$88K/Completion scheduled end of 04/23
 - **DI Helipad (off Island Park Dr. by I-526 and Seven Farms Dr.)/Emergency use only Note: Budgeted \$50K/Helipad and solar lights complete. As per FAA requirements, additional tree removal complete. Lighted windsock and solar panels to be relocated.


















Beresford Creek Bridge Update

- Removal of existing bridge








September

- Installation of temporary trestle




October

- Drive all 24" PSC piles for Bent 2








November


Drive Bent 4 Piles & Pour Cap




