## **Traffic Safety**

We are continously trying to make our neighborhood roads safer for not only vehicles, but those who walk and ride bicycles. This can be accomplished in a number of ways from simple road markings and signage to physical changes to the roads. Pima Country requires that road safety improvements to be initiated at the homeowner group level for the area of concern.

This requires a homeowner volunteer in the affected area to work with Pima County to evaluate the conditions, look at alternatives for remediation, and work with the local residents for the actual changes. Lucy Peeremboom has volunteered to be our point of contact with Pima County. We will keep you updated on our progress and future evaluations of our neighboorhood.

One way we can all help with the safety of the neighborhood is to drive 25 mph (even on Forty Niner Drive!) and encourage our family members and guests to do so as well. Remember, 49ers is a family neighborhood. Stay alive, drive 25!
