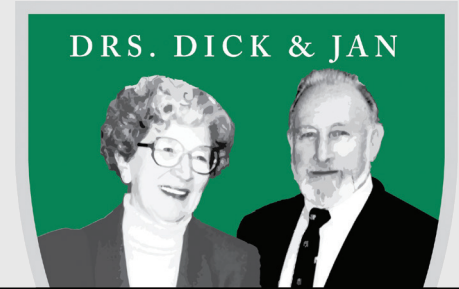

Weaver Legacy

In 1985, Drs. Dick and Jan Weaver moved to Murray. Jan had accepted the position of Dean of Education at Murray State University and Dick would continue his consultant business out of Murray. They became involved with Murray State University and the community of Murray immediately. Each one made major contributions to MSU and our community and will continue to do so through their financial endowments that will continue in perpetuity.



The Murray-Calloway County Community Foundation, Inc. ("MCCCF") was incorporated on September 30, 2010. The mission of MCCCCF is to increase philanthropic endeavors in Murray and Calloway County by developing charitable endowments. In October 2010, the MCCCCF became an affiliate member

of the Community Foundation of West Kentucky which provides valuable support.

MCCCCF began its operation with no external funding. On August 1, 2011, MCCCCF launched a three year membership Founders' Program to give residents and businesses in Calloway County an opportunity to invest in the future of their community. MCCCCF currently has 171 members.

In 2011, the Kentucky Legislature established the Endow Kentucky Tax Credit Program for gifts made to accredited community foundations in Kentucky. MCCCCF had gifts approved in 2011 and has annually obtained qualifying gifts for the Endow Tax Credit.

In 2020, MCCCCF experienced significant growth and passed the three million dollar mark with total endowments of fifty-nine. At the beginning of 2022, our total endowments were \$4,279,000 comprised of sixty-one endowments.

Non-profit organizations that have established endowments with MCCCCF include: churches, schools, music and arts organizations, parks, food insecurity programs, cemeteries, youth programs, and civic organizations among others, all serving residents of Calloway County.
