Since 1990, Rocky Mountaineer has elevated rail travel to match the grandeur of western Canada's most majestic landscapes. Now is the perfect time to join the adventure—to experience sublime comfort and service while forging new friendships and memories over gourmet meals and awe-inspiring views. You'll find the details outlined in the itinerary below.

DAY 1 | TOUR START – VANCOUVER

Arrive in Vancouver and depart by private motorcoach for a transfer to the Sheraton Wall Centre, Vancouver.

Accommodation: Sheraton Wall Centre, Vancouver ~ The Sheraton Wall Centre, Vancouver is nestled in the center of the thriving downtown district, and features the iconic One Wall Centre, the North Tower - a landmark on the Vancouver cityscape. Your hotel is a short distance from attractions like Stanley Park, Rogers Arena and Canada Place, as well as Yaletown and Robson Street. Refresh and renew in comfortable rooms with complimentary Wi-Fi, the Sheraton Signature Sleep Experience and floor-to-ceiling windows with city and ocean views.

DAY 2 | GROUP BREAKFAST AT SHERATON WALL CENTRE

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore with breath taking views of the city, ocean and surrounding mountains. Highlights include the 137 metre (450 feet) Capilano Suspension Bridge and the Grouse Mountain Skyride.

Capilano Suspension Bridge

Take a walk across the 137 metres (450 feet) long and 70 metres (230 feet) high bridge perched above the Capilano Canyon then stroll along Treetops Adventure, seven suspension bridges through the evergreens taking you above the forest floor for a squirrel's eye view of a thriving coastal rainforest.

Grouse Mountain

Take a gondola to the apex of Grouse Mountain, climbing to 4,100 feet above sea level. At the summit, take in the incredible views of Vancouver and the Pacific Ocean.

DAY 3 | COACH TRANSFER: VANCOUVER HOTEL TO STATION

Please ensure your luggage is clearly labelled with your name and contact information. Hotel staff will collect your luggage 45 minutes prior to your scheduled pick-up time. Please have your luggage ready for the bellman just inside the door to your hotel room. You are not required to wait in your room for luggage



collection. If you prefer to handle your own luggage, please advise the bell team by 8 PM the evening prior to your departure. A Rocky Mountaineer representative will greet you at the designated location within the hotel. If you have not yet checked-in for your train journey online you may do so at this time. A boarding pass and information on your Kamloops accommodation will be provided during check-in. Rocky Mountaineer luggage tags will be provided prior to boarding your motorcoach transfer. Check-in must be completed at least 5 minutes prior to your scheduled pick-up window.

VANCOUVER TO KAMLOOPS

Travel from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC Interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Breakfast & lunch are included onboard. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops between 5:30 PM and 7:30 PM. Spend the evening exploring the city of Kamloops or relaxing in your hotel room.

COACH TRANSFER: KAMLOOPS STATION TO YOUR HOTEL

Upon arrival at the Kamloops train siding, you will be transferred by motorcoach to your overnight accommodation.

KAMLOOPS ACCOMMODATION

Upon check-in for your train departure you will receive a boarding pass which will indicate your accommodation in Kamloops or the surrounding area, including Sun Peaks. Your accommodation will be of a moderate standard, but will include all the essential amenities to make your stay comfortable.

DAY 4 | COACH TRANSFER: YOUR HOTEL TO KAMLOOPS STATION

Early this morning, you will be transferred by motorcoach to the train siding from your hotel. Your pick-up times will be provided with your final travel documents.

KAMLOOPS TO LAKE LOUISE

Board the Rocky Mountaineer train at the Kamloops Station to continue your journey east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Travel across ranchlands, along rocky lakeshores, over high mountain passes and through the remarkable tunnels that form part of the rich rail history of the Canadian Rockies. Highlights include Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, the climb over Rogers Pass, the Kicking Horse Canyon, the Spiral Tunnels and, the glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Breakfast and lunch are included onboard. Your expected arrival into Lake Louise is between 6:30 PM and 8:30 PM.

LAKE LOUISE TO BANFF

Continue on to your final destination in Banff. Please note you will not disembark the train at Lake Louise. Your expected arrival time in Banff is between 7:30 PM and 9:30 PM.

COACH TRANSFER: BANFF TRAIN TO BANFF HOTEL

Upon arrival at the Rocky Mountaineer Banff Train Siding, you will be transferred to the Drop-Off Location noted in your itinerary. Please allow time for the bellmen to deliver luggage to your room.

NATIONAL PARKS PASS

Your admission to Canadian national parks is included in your package. Your pass is only valid for the number of days that you have booked accommodation in a National Park through Rocky Mountaineer.

BANFF CARIBOU LODGE AND SPA

Located in Banff National Park, the Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa offers a mountain lodge hotel, a great steakhouse restaurant and a full service spa, all in one outstanding location. This ideal vacation spot is located on Banff Avenue, the main street in the town of Banff. Surrounded by mountains, there are plenty of activities to keep you busy.

DAY 5 | GROUP BREAKFAST AT BANFF CARIBOU LODGE & SPA

All guests must check in as a group at the specified dining reservation time listed in the travel documents, otherwise the restaurant will be unable to accommodate the reservation.

SIGHTSEEING TOUR: BANFF & YOHO NATIONAL PARKS

Depart by motorcoach for your full-day tour of Banff and Yoho National Park. Yoho National Park offers magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. A stop for free time will be made at The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise for you to revel in the breathtaking surroundings of Lake Louise. Reboard your motorcoach and continue your tour concluding with a return to your Banff hotel.

MEAL: FAIRMONT CHATEAU LAKE LOUISE

Enjoy your meal(s) at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise.

DAY 7 | GROUP BREAKFAST AT BANFF CARIBOU LODGE & SPA

BANFF GONDOLA

The Banff Gondola is a spectacular eight-minute gondola ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain for 360-degree views of the Banff townsite and its surrounding mountains

GROUP HERITAGE PARK HISTORICAL VILLAGE

Discover How the West was Once at Canada's largest living history museum, Heritage Park Historical Village. This 127-acre attraction is home to the year-round Gasoline Alley Museum and is nestled on the banks of the Glenmore Reservoir with the picturesque backdrop of the majestic Rocky Mountains. Meet friendly townsfolk in full period costume as you stroll down the wooden boardwalks or pop into any number of working shops, businesses or homes.

DELTA CALGARY DOWNTOWN

Renowned for its genuine hospitality, the Delta Calgary Downtown is ideally located in downtown Calgary at the intersection of the city's business and cultural districts. Enjoy convenient access to all venues through the Calgary Skywalk system and public transportation, which makes exploring our city that much easier. When you return at the end of the day, expect the comforts of home.

DAY 8 | GROUP BREAKFAST AT DELTA CALGARY DOWNTOWN

Please re-confirm with the front desk the location and time for this morning's breakfast. The hotel will provide you with Breakfast Vouchers to be used for the Tour Breakfast that is included, which must be presented at the restaurant prior to being seated. All guests must check in as a group at the specified dining reservation time listed in the travel documents, otherwise the restaurant will be unable to accommodate the reservation.
