### Day 4: New Madrid, MO

New Madrid is known for being near the military engagement the Battle of Island Number Ten during the Civil War. ### Day 5: Cape Girardeau, MO

Cape Girardeau has shown hospitality to the likes of Mark Twain, Meriwether Lewis and William Clark, and now greets our guests in the same vein.
