## **DAY 1 | TOUR START – LAS VEGAS**

Transfer from Las Vegas Airport to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore and enjoy all that Las Vegas has to offer on your own. Overnight at The Mirage, Las Vegas or similar.

## **DAY 2 | LAS VEGAS TO BRYCE CANYON VIA ZION**

Travel across the Nevada Desert and visit Utah's oldest and most famous **Zion National Park** to admire massive 2,000-foot high formations and towers, the Mount Carmel Tunnel, Zion Canyon and the Virgin River. Lunch will be on your own today. After checking in at the hotel just outside the park, enjoy some wonderful western food and entertainment at Ebenezer's Barn and Grill. Later in the afternoon, travel through Zion Tunnel to **Bryce Canyon National Park** for an evening view. Later tonight, join the group for a private Stargazing Experience with local astronomers to explore the wonders of the night sky and our universe. Overnight at Best Western Bryce Canyon Grand Hotel or similar. Dinner included.

## **DAY 3 | BRYCE CANYON TO PAGE VIA GRAND CANYON**

Return to **Bryce Canyon National Park** for a morning view. The vibrant colors and unearthly shapes spark the imagination of both young and old. A stop will be made to have lunch on your own before entering **Grand Canyon National Park North Rim**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This 1.2-million-acre national park hosts a wonderful variety of wildlife and scenic wonders. Enjoy some free time at Grand Canyon Lodge to get a snack, explore and walk out to Bright Angel Point. Later in the afternoon, take a scenic drive and travel through Marble Canyon and pass Vermillion Cliffs to Lake Powell Resort where you'll spend the night. This evening enjoy a group dinner with a wonderful view of Lake Powell. Overnight at Lake Powell Resort, Page or similar. Breakfast and Dinner included.

## **DAY 4 | PAGE**

This morning, tour through Antelope Canyon to admire its mysterious and haunting beauty. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Powell and see the contrast of the red rock walls and emerald blue waters. A visit to Glen Canyon Dam Visitors Centre is included. There will be an optional short hike to Horseshoe Bend, followed by an evening at leisure. Overnight at Lake Powell Resort, Page or similar. Breakfast included.

## **DAY 5 | PAGE TO MOAB VIA MONUMENT VALLEY**

Depart Lake Powell and travel to Monument Valley, a sacred place to the Navajo. Your Navajo guide will take you for a scenic tour of the area to see the sights, experience the culture and traditions. Then, enjoy a lunch at historic Goulding's Lodge. In the afternoon, travel north to Moab. This evening is free to relax and explore on your own. Overnight at HooDoo Moab, Curio Collection by Hilton or similar. Breakfast and Lunch included.



## DAY 6 | MOAB

Tour the highlights of **Arches National Park**. The unique geology of the area created the highest concentration of natural arches in the world with over 2,000 named arches within the park boundary. After the tour, enjoy free time to explore Moab and have lunch on your own. In the afternoon, join the group for a Jet Boat Ride on the mighty Colorado River through spectacular red rock canyons and learn about the river's ecosystem, geology and history. Enjoy dinner with a million-dollar view at the Sunset Grill. Overnight at Hoodoo Moab, Curio Collection by Hilton or similar. Breakfast and Dinner included.

## DAY 7 | MOAB TO GLENWOOD SPRINGS

This morning transfer to **Canyonlands National Park** to visit the Island in the Sky District including the Mesa Arch and Grandview Point. Next, take a scenic drive to **Dead Horse Point State Park** for a picnic lunch. In the afternoon, board the Rocky Mountaineer train. Cross the Colorado-Utah border with stunning mountain views in the background before arriving in the resort town of Glenwood Springs. Today's dinner will be served on the train. Overnight in Glenwood Springs. Hotel to be confirmed 30 days prior to stay. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner included.

## DAY 8 | GLENWOOD SPRINGS TO DENVER

Depart Glenwood Springs and continue your journey onboard Rocky Mountaineer. Cross the Continental Divide as you take in the spectacular views of rugged canyons and Colorado River before arriving at the vibrant city of Denver. Breakfast and dinner will be served on the train. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy free time to explore Denver on your own. The LoDo district, with wonderful shops and restaurants, is within walking distance of your hotel. Overnight at Maven Hotel, Denver or similar. Breakfast and Lunch included.

## DAY 9 | DENVER

This morning, transfer to Denver Airport for your departure home.
