



Charming and Gourmet Victorian Cape May, New Jersey The Nation's Oldest Seashore Resort

Day 1: The Cape May Historic District has been designated a National Historic Landmark since 1976 and you will be staying in the heart of it! Arrive in beautiful Cape May, New Jersey for a 3-night stay at the Luxurious Southern Mansion Bed & Breakfast (built in 1863 and known as the George Allen House). Completely restored with the most modern amenities, relax in the genuine hospitality and charm of Cape May. Set on 2 acres of award-winning gardens escape to the absolute luxurious amenities and gourmet cuisine that will transport you to a calmer, simpler time. This evening, dinner will be across the street at the historic Washington Inn (built in 1846). The large columns, reaching all the way up to the third floor, were meant to resemble the plantation house of George Washington. The Washington Inn has been operated as a restaurant by the same family since 1976. After you unpack take some time to stroll the local area which is rich in history and Victorian Charm.

Day 2: Enjoy a wonderful gourmet breakfast at the Southern Mansion. After breakfast, your Trolley will arrive to pick you up for a guided tour of the Historic District. You'll be fascinated by the stories of the restored Victorian houses and Inns that you'll see along the way. Afterwards, you'll have time to explore the shops on the famous Cape May Mall and enjoy lunch on your own at one of the excellent restaurants. This afternoon when you return to the Southern Mansion, you'll have a guided tour of the Mansion. The tour is 40 minutes in length, which includes the history of the mansion, tales of its rescue and restoration. You will see all the common areas of the house as well as two guestrooms depending upon availability. Tonight, enjoy a delicious dinner at the Lobster House, one of the most famous landmarks of Cape May.

Overlooking Cape May Harbor, the atmosphere is unparalleled. The commercial fishing fleet at the Lobster House Dock supplies most of the fresh seafood served here.



Day 3: Enjoy a wonderful gourmet breakfast. This morning will be free time to stroll the beach or boardwalk. Enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon, board your motorcoach and a local guide will take you on a tour of Cape May Point State Park and Diamond Beach. Your tour will end at the winery, where you'll enjoy a tour of the vineyard, a wine tasting and a gourmet dinner. Located in New Jersey's Outer Coastal Plain, surrounded by the ocean and the bay, this beautiful 50 acre vineyard enjoys a microclimate reminiscent of Bordeaux which leads to exceptional grape harvests.
