ENTREPRENEURSHIP



They built a website for the Entrepreneurship Group to showcase their impact and connect volunteers to over 50 oppurtunities. The site supports fundraising for students in Uganda and Oaxaca. Now, they're marketing it with a goal to raise \$2.500 in two months and have already raised \$150 in the first week

BUSINESS

This month, they're preparing hygiene kits and school supplies for Ecuador, fundraising for accessories and sports gear, and finalizing booklet activities.

MEDICAL

They're working on a video project adapting the First Aid booklet into a CPR-focused video. Audio recordings and animations should be done by next week, with the full video finished in a few weeks.

VAPA

This month, they're creating art projects to send out as assignments that encourage creativity, imagination, and positive values like kindness and compassion.

HOLIDAY CONNECTIONS

They're organizing a bake sale with a goal to raise at least \$200. A recent highlight is their consistent monthly slide creation and regular bake sales.

STEM

This month, their goal is to complete the agriculture project, teaching students in Uganda farming techniques like tool-making, irrigation, pest control, and water preservation. In addition to videos, they create written curriculum covering Chemistry, Biology, tool booklets, Math, and Physics.
