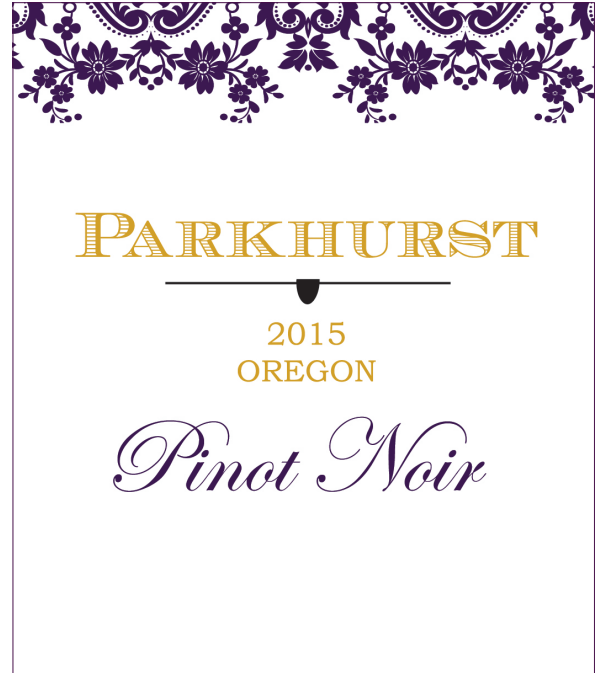

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Winemakers Notes

The aromas open with notes of preserved dark cherry, lightly smoked sandalwood, red floral and Asian spice notes followed by more subtle nuances of young raspberries. There is an herbal/savory quality that ties all the aromatics together that is reminiscent of rosemary and soft-tanned leather. The palate is beautifully round with lengthy flavors of Bing cherry, a note of plum, vanilla with salted dark chocolate through the finish. The acidity remains balanced throughout indicating that this wine would pair with a variety of foods or all on its own!
